What is...?

- → High School Equivalency Certificate: (HSE)
 - Formerly called GED
 - Gives you the credentials to apply for and attain more gainful employment
 - May lead to advancement in your current career
 - ◆ Gives you the skills and confidence to enter college and be successful
- → TASC Exam: Test Assessing Secondary Completion
 - ◆ TASC is for those who:
 - Have not graduated from an accredited high school or received a high school equivalency certificate or diploma;
 - Are not currently enrolled in a regular high school;

Who can take the test?

- → In **New York**, a person must be of "maximum compulsory school attendance age," which is **16 years old**, in order to take the test. (in NYC -17 years old)
- → Eligibility Requirements by Age:
 - ◆ If you are **16 years old**, you must meet one of the following requirements:
 - Enrolled in an Alternative High School Equivalency Program
 - Applied to the United States Armed Forces, College, or Post-Secondary Institution
 - Home schooled
 - If you are 17 to 18 years old, you must meet one of the following requirements:
 - Foreign born and never attended K-12 schools in the United States
 - One year has passed since you last enrolled in a program leading to a high school diploma
 - A member of a high school class that has graduated
 - Enrolled in an Alternative High School Equivalency Program
 - Applied to the United States Armed Forces, College, Post-Secondary Institution, or Job Corps program
 - Incarcerated or institutionalized
 - Adjudicated youth or under the direction of a prison, jail, detention center, court, parole, or probation officer
 - Home schooled
 - If you are **19 years or older**, there are no additional eligibility restrictions
