Participants <u>must</u> register in advance at <u>www.virtus.org</u>. Please arrive early so that the class may begin on time. Due to the nature of the subject, children are discouraged from attending.

This program is one component of the overall effort to protect God's children and vulnerable adults. All employees and volunteers with ongoing and unsupervised contact with children and youth are required to attend a *Protecting God's Children* session. In addition, Immaculate Conception School requires all parents, grandparents, and guardians to take this class.
