# RECYCLING GUIDELINES

#### MUST BE CLEAN AND DRY

ITEMS THAT MAY BE RECYCLED:

Plastic Bottles/Containers Numbered #1 – 7
Newspapers, Magazines, Catalogs
Soft & Hard Cover Books
All Paper and Paper Bags
Paperboard (cereal/shoe boxes)
Milk/Juice Cartons
Glass Bottles/Jars
Aluminum (pie plates/trays/foil)
Metal Cans (tin/steel/aluminum)

# **Corrugated Cardboard:**

CARDBOARD MUST BE DRY, NEAT, AND SECURED IN A BUNDLE.

NO LARGER THAN 40" LONG X 24" WIDE X 10" HIGH EACH BUNDLE MUST HAVE A YELLOW STICKER (\$8)
STICKERS ARE AVAILABLE AT L. BRACKET & SON STORE - \$8

### ITEMS THAT MAY NOT BE RECYCLED:

No plastic bags of any kind

No plastic wrap, cellophane, shrink-wrap

**No Recyclables Containing Food Waste** 

No Paper Towels, Napkins, tissue paper

No Styrofoam/ Foam Packaging

**No Unmarked Plastics** 

No Window Glass/Mirrors/Light Bulbs

No Dishes, No Pyrex, No Ceramics

No Hazardous Material

No Trash, Furniture or Appliances

No Aerosol Cans

No Paper Towels, Napkins, tissue paper

No CLOTHING
