WINE GUIDE

(S) Sustainable - otherwise known as Lutte Raisonnee in French (the reasoned struggle) is a farming practice whereby farmers first and foremost will use all methods possible to save crops before using chemical treatments, most often excellent producers who farm in marginal areas that have high disease pressure.

(O) Organic - is the growing of grapes without the use of synthetic chemical sprays.

(B) Biodynamic - builds on organic viticulture, it is philosophy based, combining the maintenance of sustainable soil fertility and the recognition of the link between plant growth and the rhythms of the cosmos. Biodynamics relies on a series of preparations based in mineral, plant and animal substances rather than the traditional potentially toxic chemicals and sprays.

(N) Natural - refers to a wine making philosophy that builds on organic or biodynamic farming practices. Wines are made without additions of any kind (other than small amounts of SO2 in some cases) and yeasts are wild rather than commercially made. In most cases the wine makers will endeavour to use grapes grown in an organic/biodynamic method
