Schedule for the Fair Queen Pageant

Saturday, July 20, 2019

<u>4:00 p.m.</u> - All Fair Queen contestants should arrive at the fairgrounds and be dressed for interview. If a contestant is not on time for competitions, they will be disqualified.

4:30 p.m. Private Interviews (closed to public)

6:30 p.m. All Fair Queen contestants should arrive at the fairgrounds to dress for swimsuit

7:00 p.m. – Swimsuit and Evening Gown Competition. The Fulton County Fair Queen Pageant will be held with the Junior Fair Queen Pageant and the Youth Talent Contest. A schedule will be published on the FB page and emailed to contestants after entry deadline.





Rules

- 1. The age for the Fulton County Fair Queen Contestants is 18 23 years on the day of the pageant.
- 2. All contestants must be residents of Fulton County. The Arkansas State Fair rule is that contestants must reside in the county where they reside. Attending school in the county does not qualify them to be in the county contest. In the event the contestant's parents are divorced and they have joint custody, the contestant must choose which county pageant to enter. She cannot enter both pageants. Contestants must have been born a female. Contestants cannot be, or at any time have been married, pregnant, or have given birth to a child. A contestant must have not ever have been convicted of a crime or have criminal charges pending.
- 3. A previous year's winner of the Fulton County Fair Queen Pageant and any Arkansas State Fair Fair Queen winner is not eligible to compete in the Fulton County Fair Queen Pageant. If they have already entered a fair beauty pageant during the current calendar year, they are not eligible to enter the Fulton County pageant. The previous year's queen will crown the winner of this year's contest.
- 4. Each Fair Queen contestant (age 18 23) must pay a registration fee. Fees are \$20.00 if paid by July 10, 2019 and \$25.00 if paid July 11 July 15, 2019. No entries will be accepted after July 15, 2019. All entry forms must be typed or printed and signed by parent or guardian. Entry fees will not be refunded. Entry fees can be paid online with a credit card.

5. COMPETITION CLOTHING:

- a. Interview Dress or suit, jewelry and shoes of choice no hats, gloves, or purses.
- b. Swimsuit Swimsuits should be one-piece and appropriate in taste. No monokinl swimsuits allowed.
- c. **Evening gown E**vening gown of choice. Jewelry and accessories should be tasteful and compliment the gown. High-heeled shoes are recommended, but not required.
- d. No visible tattoos. If a contestant has tattoo, they must be covered.
- 6. Judges will be from out-of-county and will be selected by Zeta Omicron Chapter of Beta Sigma Phi. Judges decision is final. Judges names will not be released after the contest.
- 7. Awards will be provided to the winner and 1st and 2nd runner-up. A Miss Congeniality Award will be voted on by the contestants and announced at the pageant.
- The winner of the Fulton County Fair Queen pageant will represent Fulton County in the Arkansas State Fair Queen Pageant in Little Rock on October 16, 2019. <u>All other contestants are eligible to enter the North</u> <u>Central Arkansas Junior Fair Queen Pageant at Melbourne on September 28, 2019.</u>
- 9. The winner of the Fulton County Fair Queen Pageant must complete the Arkanss State fair Entry Form and complete a resume. It must be signed by the contestant, parent or guardian and the county pageant director. The pageant director will email the entry form and resume to the Arkansas State Fair within 5 days after the County Fair ends. The Arkansas State Fair Queen Pageant entry form is available online and must be typed.
- 10. Winners are encouraged to partipate in the local parades such as Christmas Parades and the Fulton County Homecoming Festival Parade and help with ribbon cuttings, award programs and other events in the county.
- 11. Admission: The contestant and one parent will get in free.
