Dear Member,

Once again it is time, for the voting members in good standing, to prioritize, via balloting, the list of judges to be contracted to judge our upcoming National and/or Regional specialty shows.

Please note that this only pertains to shows in which the STCA, Inc. National club is solely hosting the show. Other clubs hosting shows like Regional clubs are allowed to select judges of their own choosing.

Enclosed are 3 separate ballots for the years 2016, 2017, and 2018 respectively. Each ballot needs to be filled out by you in a valid fashion. You then must return the ballots via your chosen valid method in order to be included in the tabulations for each year.

In order for your ballots to be valid, compliant, and included in the tabulations, you need to read and understand the complete Judges Selection Procedure for our club. This Judges Selection Procedure is enclosed for reading.

The valid pool of judges eligible to have their AKC number written on the ballots is also enclosed.

Since this pool of judges is set as of this mailing, please fill out your ballots from only this list to have your ballots be valid.

Via this balloting process, a prioritized list of judges, to be contacted in order, for each of the years above will be developed. This means that three prioritized lists will be developed. The first judge willing and able to commit to our show for each year is then hired to judge our show(s) for that year.

Ballots may be submitted by mail. If submitted by mail the ballots must be postmarked and received by August 31st of the same year this procedure began. No ballots will be accepted by mail after the cutoff date.

Ballots may be submitted via hand delivery to the club's Recording Secretary at the National show. All hand delivered ballots will be accepted up to the start of the Annual Membership Meeting. Please remember that members can only submit their own ballots or those of family members.

Please don't delay if you desire to be included in this procedure. Hurry and fill out your valid ballots. Then hurry and get them properly returned before the cutoff date.

STANDING RULE SR5:

Judge's Selection Procedure

Nomination forms for selection of a National specialty conformation judge shall be mailed by the Judges Selection Committee to every member in good standing, as defined in the bylaws, and returned, by mail, postmarked by August 31. The mailing shall be conducted in even-numbered years. The nomination form shall encompass selection for three years of conformation judges. Completed nomination forms may also be hand delivered to the Club Recording Secretary no later than the commencement of the Annual Membership Meeting and prior to the count being tallied and reported during the meeting. Hand delivered nomination forms can only be submitted by members on their own behalf, or that of a family member. Under no circumstance is a member of the Judges Selection Committee, including its chairperson, eligible to be listed on the ballot while serving on the committee. Refer to the STCA website for further details and requirements.

OVERALL RULES:

Please note that this only pertains to shows in which the STCA, Inc. National club is solely hosting the show. Other clubs hosting shows like Regional clubs are allowed to select judges of their own choosing.

This balloting and voting procedure will encompass multiple years. Separate ballots for each respective year will be specified on each ballot. These rules and procedures will be in effect for each year respectively.

Only STCA, Inc. Members in good standing with voting rights (per the STCA, Inc. by-laws), as of the date of the Club's mailing, are eligible to participate in this balloting and voting procedure. These members shall be termed valid members.

Ballots returned by a valid member will only be tabulated via this procedure if the member is still in good standing with the AKC and the STCA, Inc. Clubs when the tabulation of the ballots occurs.

A pool of valid judges to be utilized for balloting shall be developed. This pool of valid judges shall be set as of the date of the Club's mailing.

The pool of valid judge's to be utilized for balloting will be provided to each valid member and included in the Club's mailing via a paper listing or via reference to a website to view the listing.

The pool of valid judges listing will include each judge's name along with his or hers AKC judging number along with a notation denoting each judge's eligibility status to be chosen as a judge for any given year under consideration. This listing may also include for each judge the most recent and previous judging assignment year(s) (if any), along with a notation of which show was judged.

For balloting purposes, only the AKC judging number will be accepted on the ballots from valid members to identify each and every one of their judging choices.

The pool of valid judges will be a listing of only approved judges, not pending judges, verified and eligible to judge American Staffordshire Terriers. The pool will be developed via the AKC's website, via an AKC special report, or the current AKC's Judge's Directory. The only valid judges in this balloting and voting process shall come from this pool.

A judge's number may appear only once on any given year's ballot for the ballot to be valid.

For any given year, if a judge has judged the National Specialty or Regional Specialty in conjunction with the National Specialty in any of the previous five years prior to the given year, the judge is ineligible to judge the show.

MAILING FROM THE CLUB:

This procedure will begin with a mailing from the Club to each valid member (as specified above).

The mailing will include either these procedures or a reference to a web site where these procedures may be read. It will also include separate ballots for each respective year that this procedure entails.

The Club mailing may or may not include a self-addressed return envelope(s), a postage paid self-addressed return envelope(s), self-addressed post card type ballots, or postage paid self-addressed post card type ballots.

For each respective year that this procedure entails, a separate balloting form specifically designating the respective year for each ballot will be mailed to each member in good standing using the voting membership list provided by the Recording Secretary as of the date of the mailing.

For each respective ballot, the ballot will also include 3 specific sections to be filled out by the member. These 3 specific areas shall be designated first judge choice, second judge choice, and third judge choice. Accompanying each section shall be an area for the member to write in a judge's number. Each valid member may designate up to 3 separate and distinct judges, via the judge's AKC number, of the member's choosing for any one year.

Each respective ballot shall also include the return address for the ballot, a place for the printed name of the member to be filled out by the member, a place for the member to sign the ballot, and a place for the member to input the date when the ballot was completed.

A pool of the valid Judges will be sent with the balloting forms or a reference to a website to view this pool of valid judges list will be included. The pool of valid Judges will be as of the date specified on the listing and set as of the mailing. The list or pool of valid judges will include each respective judge's name and AKC judge's number.

MEMBERS SUBMITTING BALLOTS FOR TABULATION:

Members can only submit their own ballots or those of family members.

Ballots returned for tabulation must have the member's name and address easily seen and legible on the outside of any sealed container (like an envelope) or on each postcard ballot.

Members who are unable to attend the National Specialty must have their ballots postmarked before the cutoff date listed in these procedures to be tabulated.

Ballots may be submitted by mail. If submitted by mail the ballots must be postmarked and received by August 31st of the same year this procedure began. No ballots will be accepted by mail after the cutoff date

Ballots may be submitted via hand delivery to the club's Recording Secretary at the National show. All hand delivered ballots will be accepted up to the start of the Annual Membership Meeting. Please remember that members can only submit their own ballots or those of family members.

MEMBERS FILLING OUT A VALID BALLOT:

This applies to each of the separate ballots for each respective year that this procedure entails.

Each member must complete his or her own ballots.

Each member should read these procedures, or refer to the web site where these procedures may be read.

Each member should reference the included pool of the valid Judges or refer to the website to view this pool of valid judges list.

For each respective ballot, the member should legibly fill in the desired judge's number in the 3 specific sections to be filled out by the member. These 3 specific areas are designated first judge choice, second judge choice, and third judge choice. Each valid member may designate up to 3 separate and distinct judges of the members choosing for any one year. Only one judge's number may appear per section per ballot.

A judge's number can only appear once for any given year or ballot. In other words, only up to three distinct judges' numbers may appear on any one ballot form. Duplicate judges' numbers on any one ballot form will result in an invalid ballot. Invalid ballots will not be utilized in tabulation.

For each respective ballot, the member should print his or her name in the place provided, sign the ballot in the place provided, and input the date when the ballot was completed in the place provided.

Regardless of the method of return for tabulation, ballots returned for tabulation must have the member's name and address easily seen and legible on the outside of any sealed container (like an envelope) or on each postcard type ballot.

Each member should verify the validity of each of their ballots then return the ballots to the address shown on the ballots via the appropriate mailing method before the cutoff date. As an alternative, each member may hand deliver their ballots. All of this is explained and provided for in these procedures.

PROCESSING BALLOTS RECEIVED BY MAIL:

BALLOTS NOT WITHIN CUTOFF DATES:

Ballots received by mail will be verified for proper cutoff dates. Ballots not meeting the cutoff date will be separated into a container labeled "Did not meet cutoff date" and will not be tabulated any further. Ballots within the cutoff dates will be processed further.

BALLOTS WITHIN CUTOFF DATES:

Ballots returned from members will have their membership and voting status verified (i.e. Members in Good Standing) via the return name and address provided by the member when returned.

Each sealed container (i.e. envelope) or postcard type ballot will have documented upon it "received by mail" with the date and time of receipt.

Ballots received in a sealed container or via a postcard type ballot then will be separated into two containers: 1) Voting Members in Good Standing, 2) Non-eligible members.

PROCESSING BALLOTS HAND DELIVERED:

Ballots may be hand delivered up to the start of the Annual Membership Meeting. Please note all the rules presented throughout these procedures.

Each sealed container (i.e. envelope) or postcard type ballot will have documented upon it "received by hand" with the date and time of receipt.

Ballots not meeting the cutoff date and time will be separated into a container labeled "Did not meet cutoff date" and will not be tabulated any further. Ballots within the cutoff date and time will be processed further.

Ballots hand delivered from members will have their membership and voting status verified (i.e. Members in Good Standing) via the return name and address provided by the member when returned.

Ballots received in a sealed container or via a postcard type ballot then will be separated into two containers: 1) Voting Members in Good Standing, 2) Non-eligible members.

VERIFICATION AND TABULATION:

The tabulation process will be conducted during the National Specialty show week.

The tabulation location will be publicly announced and occur in a public place for all members and non-members to attend, during the National Specialty show week.

A Tabulation Committee will be formed from three random members present. Their charter is to verify, count and tabulate the ballots submitted.

VERIFICATION:

This Tabulation Committee will verify that all ballots are properly categorized regarding meeting the cutoff dates and times in the container labeled "Did not meet cutoff date". Should a ballot be found to be valid, then it will be separated into the appropriate container labeled either 1) Voting Members in Good Standing, 2) Non-eligible members.

The Tabulation Committee will verify that all the ballots in the container labeled "Non-eligible members" are in fact either not voting members and/or not members in good standing. If an error is discovered, then the ballots will be separated into the container labeled "Voting Members in Good Standing" if it meets the cutoff dates.

This committee will verify that all ballots in the container labeled "Voting Members in good Standing" are in fact valid voting members in good standing. They will also verify that the ballots meet the appropriate cutoff dates. Ballots in error will be separated into the appropriate container either: 1) "Non-eligible members" or 2) "Did not meet cutoff date".

TABULATION:

Only the container labeled "Voting Members in Good Standing" shall be tabulated.

Sealed containers (i.e. envelopes) will be opened and each ballot shall be documented with the appropriate "received by mail" or "received by hand" data shown on the container. In addition the date received will also be documented on each ballot.

Ballots will then be placed into the appropriately labeled year container for further processing.

Postcard type ballots (already documented) will then be placed into the appropriately labeled year container for further processing.

Each individual year container shall then be processed respectively and separately.

Each individual ballot in each year's container will be processed for validity. Each ballot must have the member's name printed on the ballot along with the member's signature and date of ballot completed. Ballots without this information will be deemed invalid and rejected and noted as such. Invalid ballots will not be processed.

Each ballot will then be verified for up to 3 unique judge numbers. If multiple occurrences of a judge's number are found on a ballot, then it will be deemed invalid and rejected and noted as such. Invalid ballots will not be processed.

The nominated judge's numbers on the ballot will be verified as to their eligibility via the pool of valid judges. Illegible or invalid judges' numbers will not be tabulated.

Each ballot for each valid member will then be tabulated. Each member is able to choose three judges via the AKC judge's number, and each is ranked by 1st thru 3rd choices. Each member's 1st choice nomination will be awarded 3 points and each 2nd place choice will be awarded 2 points, and each 3rd place choice will be awarded 1 point.

This process may be done manually or via an automated process if one is developed and available.

For each year and after every valid ballot for that year has been processed, a point tabulation for each judge will occur. The judge with the most accumulated points shall be ranked 1st and so on down in succession to the judge with the least amount of points. This prioritized list of judges will become the official list of judges to be contacted in order for that year. This list will be utilized first for the judge of our National Specialty show and again for our judge of our Regional Specialty show held in conjunction with our National if one is held.

The prioritized list of judges for each year will be posted and listed on the STCA website, as well as the STCA Specialty's Facebook page.

The ballots processed for each year will then be placed into a container labeled for that year. These ballots and this procedure will be available for viewing by any member present during the week of the National Specialty by coordinating a meeting with the Recording Secretary and the Judges Selection Committee Chairperson.

All containers will be sealed and sent to the Recording Secretary for storage.

HIRING AND COMMITTING A JUDGE:

Hiring, contacting, committing and contracting a judge will be the responsibility of a person designated by the Board of Directors of the Club for the prospective year they have been chosen for.

Utilizing the prioritized list of judges for each year each judge, beginning with the first judge listed, will be contacted in the prioritized list's order to obtain a commitment from the judge to judge our show. A judge must somehow expressly deny a commitment before any subsequent judge may be contacted in order from the prioritized list.

Once again, starting with the first judge listed (highest number of points tabulated in any given year), no judge will be contacted further down the list unless and until the judge above it has expressly not been able to commit to our request to judge our show for that year for any reason.

A commitment for a Regional judge will only be necessary if a Regional show is held in conjunction with our National Specialty show for any given year. The process of obtaining a commitment from a judge to judge our Regional show will not commence until a commitment has been obtained from a judge to judge our National show for the same year. After a commitment has been obtained from a judge to judge our National show, then the exact same process explained above will be followed until a commitment is received from a judge to judge our Regional show for the same year.

Please note: Our National Specialty judge will not always be listed higher on the prioritized list of judges for any given year than our Regional Specialty judge for the same year. Travel times, logistics, scheduling conflicts and AKC rules for judging are just a few examples and valid reasons why the above may occur.

Once verbal commitments have been gained, the person designated by the Board of Directors will send written contracts to the judges for the prospective year. The contracts will verify each judge's availability to judge for the date and location of the show, as well as, verify the fees and expenses that will be charged to the club.

Once a signed contract is received back from the judge, then the selected judge's name will be posted on the STCA website, as well as the National Club's Facebook Page.
