To turn this covenant into an irrevocable Blessing

- Give God your firstfruits. (Neh. 10:35-37, Prov. 3:9, Gen. 22:16-18, Heb. 6:13-18)
- **Firstfruit means to consider God first in the allocation of your time, talent, treasures, affections and relationships**
- The firstfruit offering is 100% of your 1st month, 1st two-weeks, 1st week, or 1st Day income, according to your faith. It is not the tithe which is 10%. (Gen. 4:4, Ex. 23:19, Rom. 11:16, Neh. 10:36-37)
- It is a once a year offering. Except if you receive a pay raise within the year. In that case the difference will be another firstfruit offering.
- The tithe opens the floodgates of heaven, the firstfruit determines the size of the blessing that comes out of that floodgate (Mal. 3:10-11)
- **Bring your firstfruits on any Sunday before March 2017, or whenever you earn your first pay this year, mark it firstfruits and drop it in the offering basket. It is a covenant between you and God.**
