## BYLAW NO.161 OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF YELLOWSTONE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA

BEING A BYLAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF DISPOSING OF A PORTION OF MUNICIPAL RESERVE (AS DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS IN #1 BELOW) AND ON THE PROPOSED PLAN OF SUBDIVISION SHOWN IN ATTACHMENT "A".

**WHEREAS** Section 674 of the Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000 authorizes a municipality to enact a bylaw to dispose of a municipal reserve;

**AND WHEREAS,** it is deemed desirable to dispose of a portion of a municipal reserve:

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Summer Village of Yellowstone in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT a 3.05 Metre wide portion of lot R1, Plan 7236KS that measures 46.86 Metres on its western side and 46.14 Metres on its eastern side, and as shown on the Proposed plan of Subdivision dated April 24, 2007 and prepared by Don Wilson Surveys Ltd (Attachment "A") be disposed of as Municipal Reserve.
- 2. THAT this bylaw shall come into force and have effect after both the third reading of this bylaw, and upon registration of the aforementioned subdivision.

READ A SECOND TIME THIS 12<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF December, AD 2007.
