Q: How much time, energy and/or expense are you interested in putting into garden maintenance and development? Do you plan to hire an outside garden maintenance service? (For Example: professional weekly or bi-weekly maintenance programs can average around \$1800-\$2000/year, whereas quarterly maintenance programs can average around \$600-\$800. Of course this can vary with size and scope of work and no two gardens are exactly alike.)
