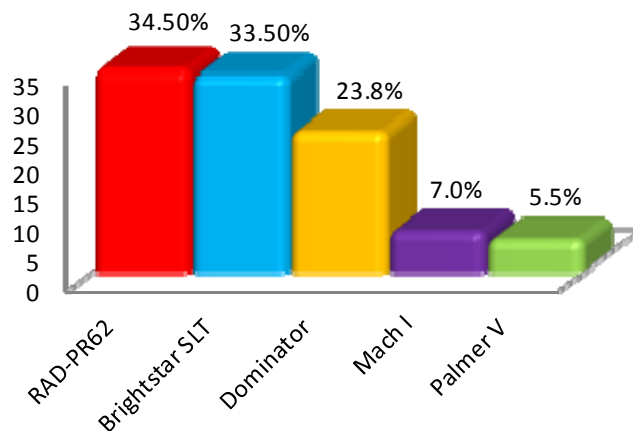
Seeding Rates:

Permanent Turf:
7-8 lbs./1,000 square feet

Overseeding:
20 - 25 lbs./1,000 square feet

Salt problems are of great concern in the arid and semi-arid regions where salt content of soils are naturally high and precipitation is not enough to leach out the soluble salts. Problems associated with saline soils and saline irrigation water may increase in the future as more marginal quality waters are applied to turf sites. One of the most efficient ways to improve the health of the turfgrass in salinity stress situations is to select and use salinity tolerant cultivars like **Pepper (RAD-PR62)**. **Pepper** showed superior salt tolerance at 15,000 PPM, rating in the top 10 for all Perennial ryegrass cultivars.

Other characteristics of **Pepper** are fine leaf texture, excellent wear tolerance, great living ground cover and resistance to red thread.
