Edward Rodriquez\* 1953\*Age 17 1/2 \*USMC

Eddie Rodriguez enlisted for a 3 year tour of duty in the US Marine Corp. at the age of 17-1/2 in November 1953, He took his basic training at Camp Pendelton, CA. Military policy at the time required service personnel to be at least 18 years old before deployment to a foreign country. Eddie turned 18 in May 1954, and in June of that year he received orders to board a troop transport ship bound for South Korea with a 2-day stopover in Kobe, Japan. Eddie had been trained as a radio operator after finishing basic

training, but upon arriving in Korea he found out that switchboards were the primary mode of communication "number please". Even though an Armistice Agreement was signed on July 27, 1953, his unit was shelled several times starting in 1954 while he was stationed there. Eddie served a little more than a year in Korea and after his tour there ended he completed his time in the Marines again at Camp Pendleton.

A total of 17 medals were awarded, 15 were presented to living Korean war veterans, 1 to the family of a serviceman who was killed in action,. and 1 to the family of a serviceman who is still classified as missing in action. They all served during the Korean War from June 1950 to July 1953, or are veterans who participated in the UN peacekeeping operations in Korea until the end of 1955.

A peace treaty was never signed. The Korean War has never officially ended.
