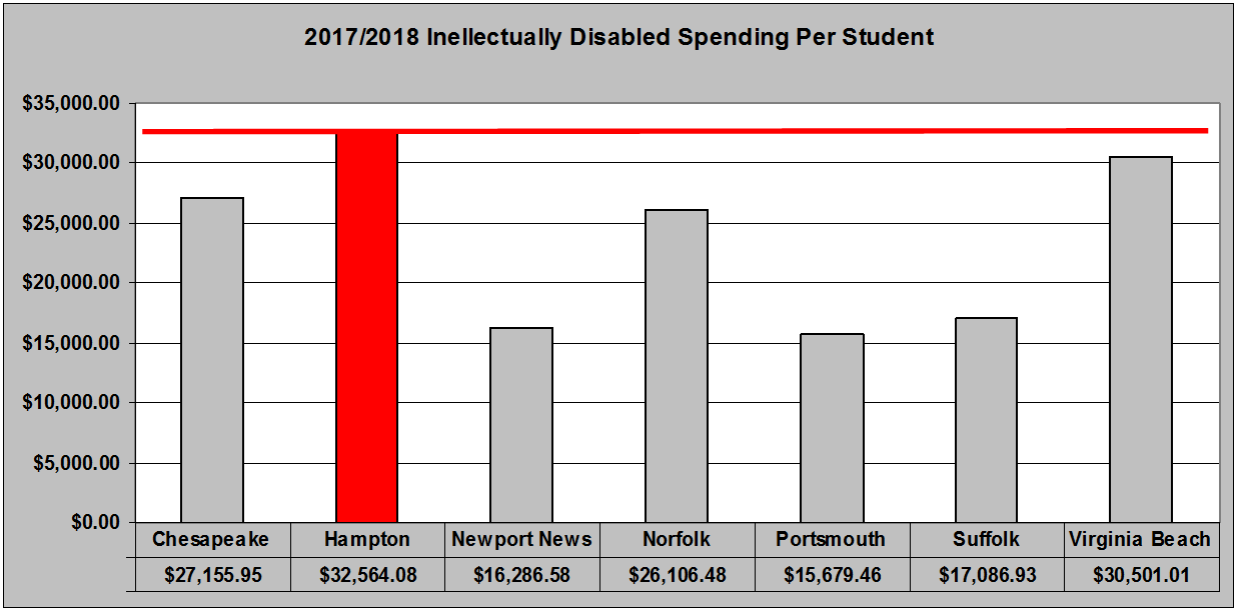
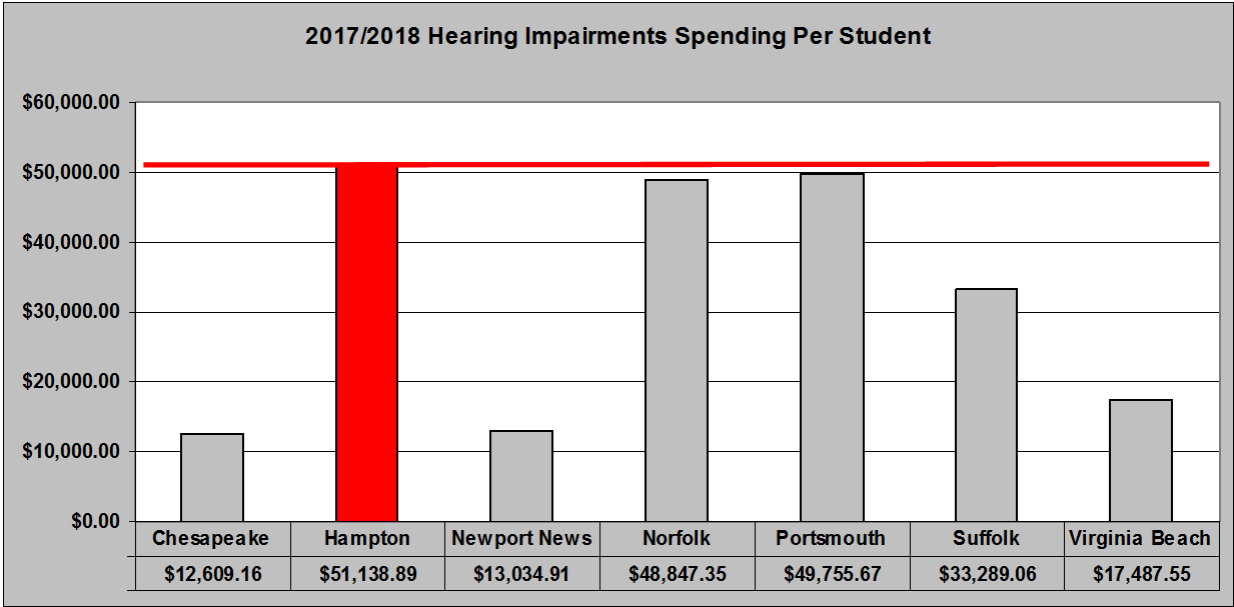


2017/2018 Developmentally Delayed Spending Per Student

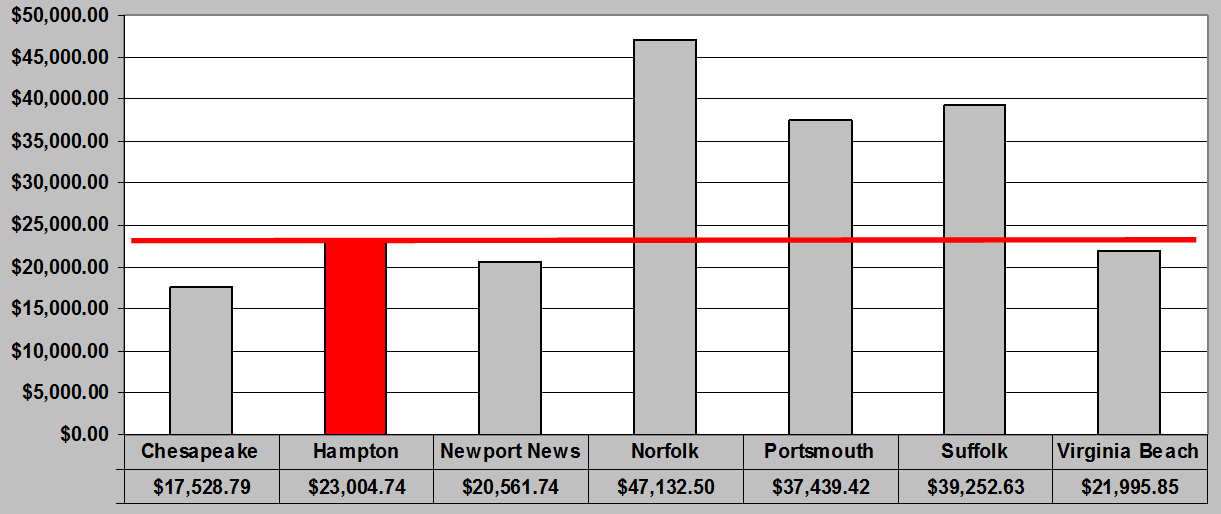


2017/2018 Emotional Disturbance Spending Per Student

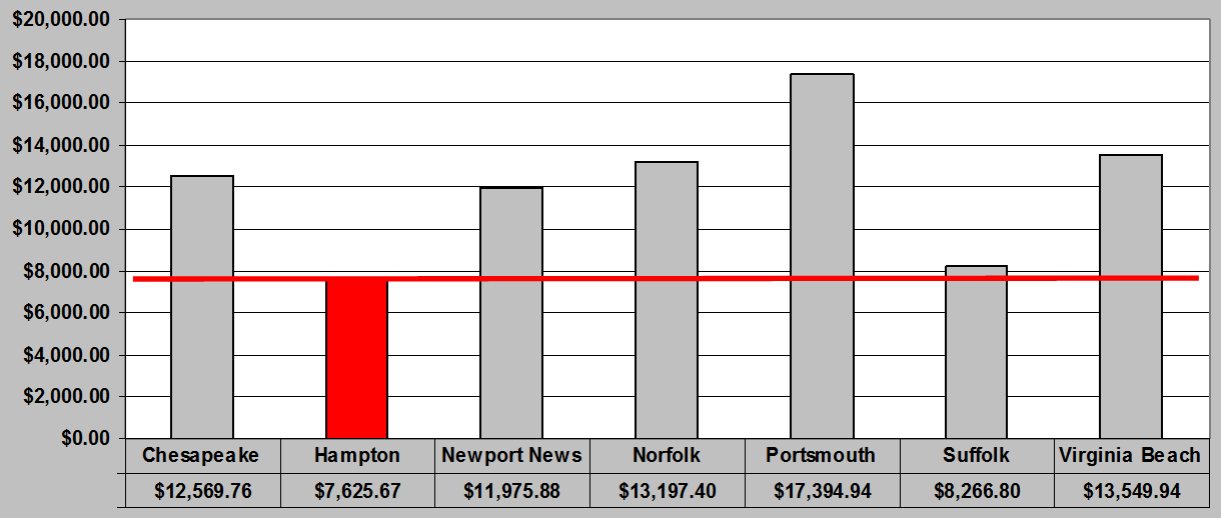




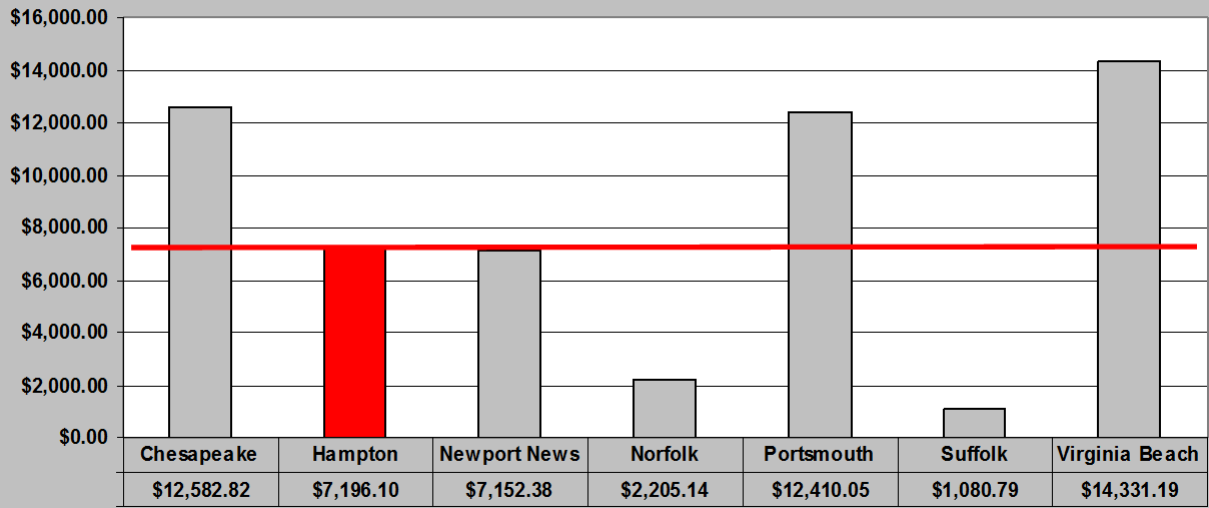
2017/2018 Multiple Disabilities Spending Per Student



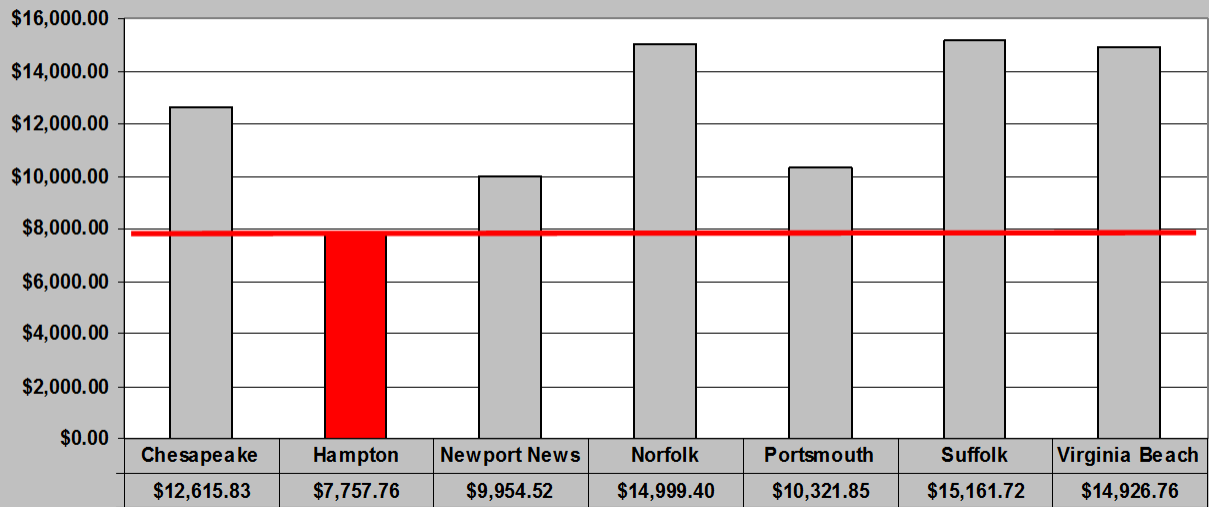
2017/2018 Orthopedic Impairments Spending Per Student



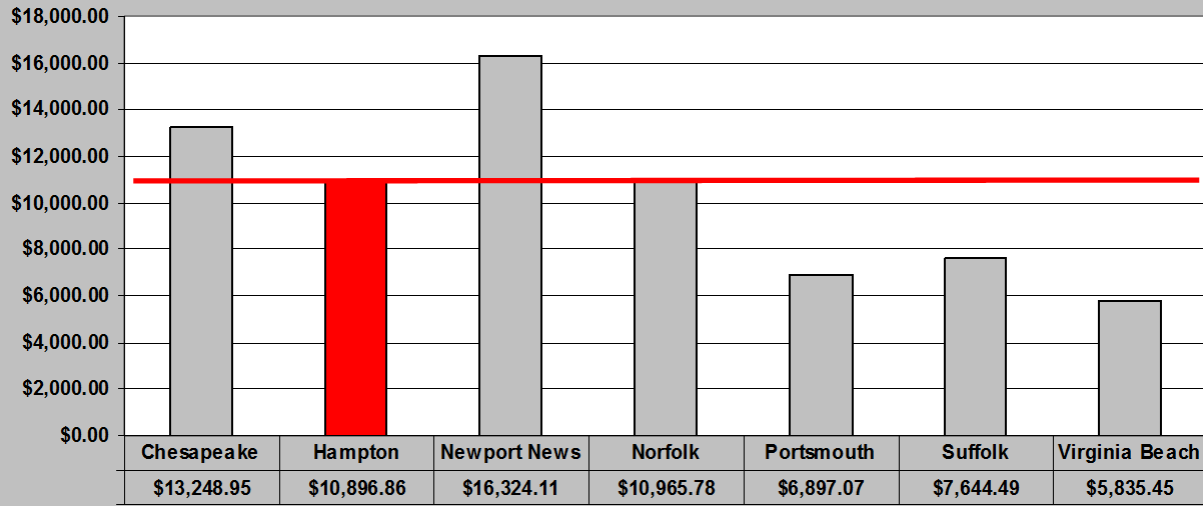
2017/2018 Other Health Impairments Spending Per Student



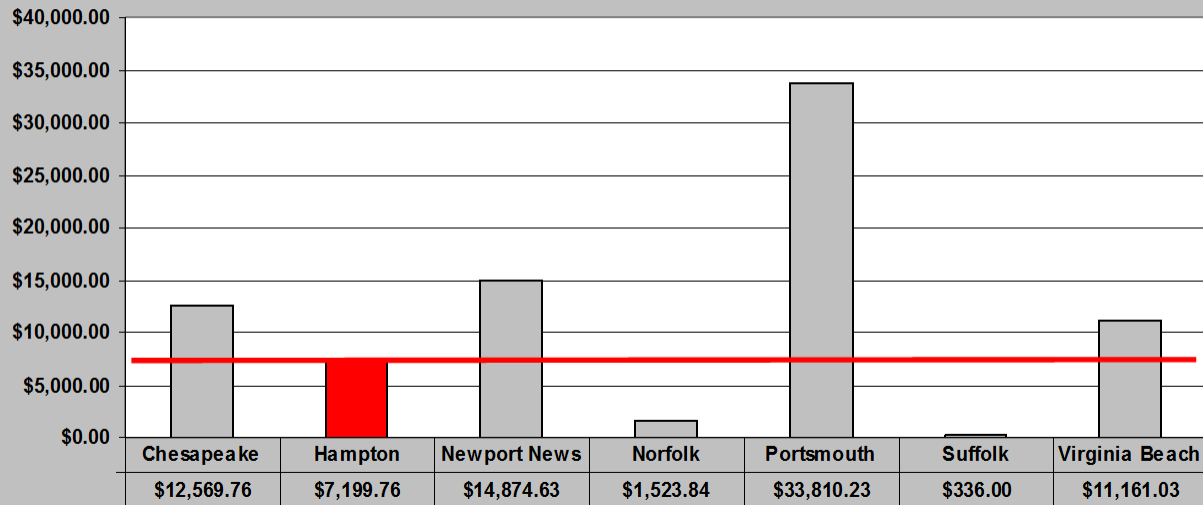
2017/2018 Specific Learning Disabilities Spending Per Student

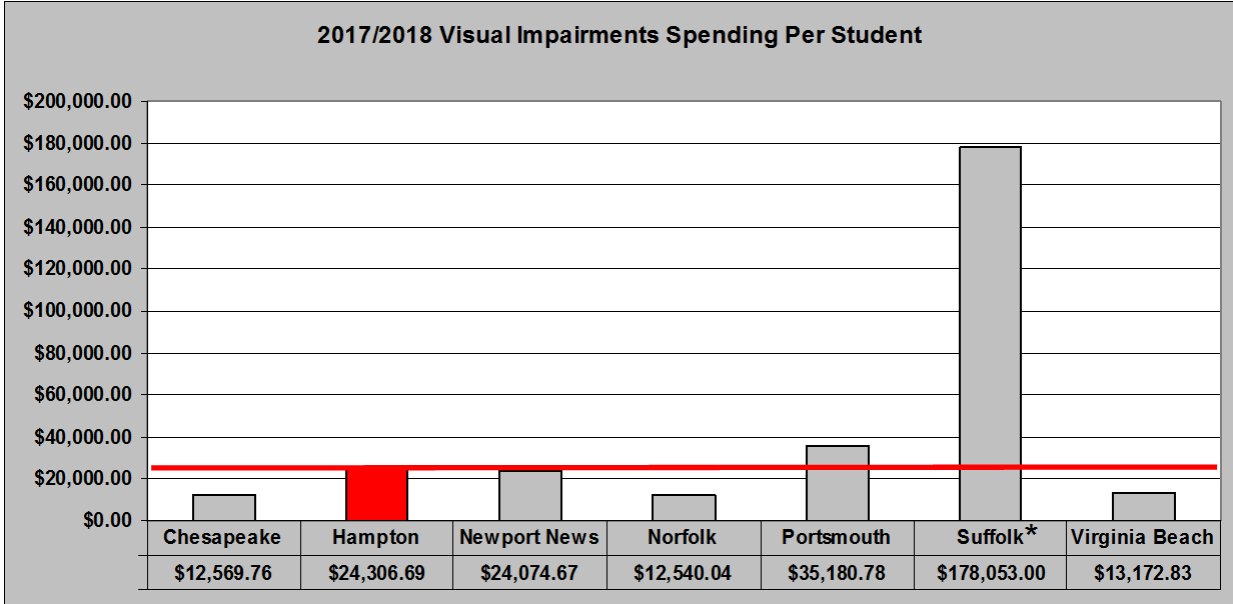


2017/2018 Speech or Language Impairments Spending Per Student
