Projects completed this year:

Updates:

 The Colonial Hills Website got a well-deserved update. It should now be easier to navigate and find needed documents. Based on feedback from community members, the board is working on being more transparent!

> Reminders:

- Per Hillsborough County Ordinances, trash cans are to be placed above the curb, not in the street. Trash cans that are left in the street can become a traffic hazard.
 - Overfilling can cause spillage. The driver is not permitted pick sills up, however, if the driver drops glass containers or other hazards, you can call to report the incident.

- Follow appropriate traffic laws:
 - The speed limit in the neighborhood, as posted in the entrance is 25 mph.
 - STOP at stop signs.
 - Do not block the entrance to the neighborhood when waiting for bus drop-offs. Please pick one side of the street. Do not park on the swale due to location of sprinkler heads at the entrance.
 - Do not park on corners. This blocks visibility or accessibility for larger vehicles trying to navigate.
