**Foundations of Obedience I Class from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, Monday nights FULL**

**Foundations of Obedience I Class from 7:15 - 8:15 pm, Monday nights starting on 12/10/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** This class will teach the foundation skills for having a well-rounded family pet, and for competitive obedience. Attention, heeling, sits and downs, sit/wait with attention, stand for exam, recall games, and stays will be covered. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work to build a solid relationship with your dog. This class is also useful as a basis for dogs/handler planning on agility. **No class on 12/24/2018 and 12/31/2018**

**Tricks Class from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, Tuesday nights starting 12/11/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II, or have instructor's approval.

**Description:** This class will present and practice novice, intermediate, and advanced tricks. Your dog can be certified in both *Do more With Your Dog* tricks Program or AKC. Pat Kelm is a certified evaluator for both! Tricks testing will take during instructional time. Each one-hour session is filled with challenges, obstacles, and fun! Max. 6 students. **No class on 12/25 and 1/1/2019.**

**Pawsitively Fun from 7:15 - 8:15 pm, Tuesday nights starting 12/11/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II, or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** A fun class for you and your dog while reviewing and proofing obedience skills, learning new tricks, playing games, and enhancing confidence skills and canine fitness. Max. 8 students.. **No class on 12/25/2019 and 1/1/2019.**

**Beginners Scent Work Fun from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, Monday nights starting 1/7/2019**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have instructor's approval.

**Description:** This class will introduce you and your canine partner to the fun sport of Scent Work. In this class you will learn how to stimulate and refine your dog's desire to hunt by scent. By the end of this course, you will learn how to train your dog to hunt for specific odors. Equipment and gear overview will also be covered. Class instructor is Kathi Gullace. Class size limited to *eight* handler & dog teams.

**Advanced Scent Work Fun from 7:00 - 8:00 pm, Monday nights starting 1/7/2019**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I, Scent Work Fun I or have instructor's approval.

**Description:** This class builds on skills from Scent Work Fun I, and introduces new skills. Class instructor is Kathi Gullace. Class size limited to *eight* handler & dog teams.

**Competition Obedience Class from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, Wednesday nights starting 12/12/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** Traditional CD/CDX class for those wanting to compete, and earn their CD and/or CDX. Drop-ins for this class are permitted.

**Advanced Obedience / Rally from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, Wednesday nights starting 12/12/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I & II or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** Traditional Rally class for those wanting to compete and earn a Rally title. All levels of rally signs will be incorporated to meet individual needs of handlers. Drop-ins for this class are permitted.

**Foundations of Obedience II Class from 7:15 - 8:15 pm, Wednesday nights starting 12/12/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed the Foundations of Obedience I or have equivalent skills.

**Description:** Behaviors such as stay, coming when called, walking on-leash & off-leash, are practiced with distractions using creative, fun games and exercises. Teaching your dog to focus on you when the environment gets busy is essential to a happy life with your dog. This class provides excellent preparation for trainers interested in dog sports: agility, competition obedience, and rally obedience. The AKC Canine Good Citizen Exam will be available after this class.

**Puppy Class from 6:00 - 7:00 pm, Thursday nights starting 12/13/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs need to be 12 weeks to 6 months old and must have current shots.

**Description:** The goal of the puppy class is to help you and your new puppy get to know each other and to introduce basic obedience concepts to the puppy. A major part of this class is socialization with other people and other dogs. This is done in a class setting where concepts of attention and walking on a leash are introduced. AKC Star Puppy test is available at the end of this class.

**Puppy Plus/Manners from 7:15 - 8:15 pm, Thursday nights starting 12/13/2018**

**Prerequisites:** Dogs should have completed a puppy class or have equivalent skills. For small-breed dogs up to 18 months-old, and large-breeds up to 12 months-old with Instructor's approval.

**Description:** This class is designed for further socialization of young dogs. Basic skills of heeling, recalls, sits, downs, and stays will be reinforced. Manners for having a well-rounded family pet will be a focus of this class. Class will be fun and motivational with games and attention work, to build a solid relationship with your young dog.
