Below are answers to the questions we left for follow up from the 12/4 LMKA meeting that Seth and I attended. Please post this for the members. Thanks!

We have informed the new owners of the Parmalee property via a letter on December 6th of the infestation of iguanas on their property. We have let them know that this is a concern to adjacent property owners and also informed them of the negative impacts the iguanas have. We provided them with information on where to learn more about iguanas and also provided them contact information with the FWC for eradication issues.

I have heard back from FDOT officials and unfortunately there are no scheduled vegetation plantings in the right of ways anywhere within Islamorada for the next year.

The boat that skims the floating vegetation in canals is owned and operated by Adventure Environmental Inc., based in Tavernier. The cost would be based on the individual job, but the last time the county used the service they were charged \$1900 per day for a full day's work.
