


### Inner Ear Anatomy












### Firing Rate Varies With Head Movement






### Vestibulo-ocular Reflex




# <section-header>VOR - Vestibulo-Occular Reflex Head movement to Left excitation on left inhibition on right eyes drift right nystagmus beats left

### Vertebrobasilar Circulation

Blood supply to the inner ear comes from AICA (Anterior Inferior Cerebellar Artery)



### **Inner Ear Circulation**

The Labyrinthine artery is a branch of AICA and is small enough that ischemia to the inner ear structures affects both the auditory and vestibular components
