Here is an excerpt from his obituary:

George Jacob Coe, 4/2/1927-7/1/2017

Born in New Haven, Connecticut, George graduated from the University of Connecticut in 1950 with an engineering degree. One of his most notable jobs was working with the original astronauts on the Gemini Spacecraft, and he was a principle member of the team that designed the first Military Satellite Program. George and his family lived many years in Los Altos before he and his wife moved to Auburn to retire in 2000. George was active in the community, Auburn Symphony and Meddlers. He was an active trombonist and participated in several bands, most recently the Auburn Winds. He had many hobbies including painting with water colors, playing Bridge and woodworking.
