Minutes of the BAQG January 2021 General Meeting – Kelly Gibson – Secretary

The Quilt show is the guild's main fund-raising activity.

Gloria Hill presented the Treasurer's report. The guild's new budget has been reduced to reflect lower guild activity. The annual audit of the guild's books will take place in January 2021 and the results are expected to be presented next month. Jane mentioned the guild is not doing the Tool Time activity at monthly guild meetings. The guild is looking at other activities to raise funds. One idea discussed is to participate in the annual Sterling High School craft show and sell sewing related crafts, perhaps potholders. Jan Cobb is the guild librarian. If guild members have book donations, they can be provided to Jan. Jan introduced one of the meeting's special guest, Davida Hinton. Davida was one of the founding members of the guild. Delores Ellis and Connie Schofield presented the guild's current donation quilt to the membership. The 2021 Block of the Month program is being developed. It may be executed differently this year, perhaps on a quarterly basis instead of monthly. More details are coming. Vicki Carroll, Connie Schofield, Laura Workman and Grace Hans presented beautiful quilts at Show and Tell. Gloria Hill showed members a recently completed wallet project. Door prizes were presented by Jane. Cindie Stolz received the member in attendance prize. Kelly Alvarez received the drawing prize for attending guests. Jeannine Cross won the nametag prize.

This month's meeting features a in house quilt shop hop for the members. Several local quilts shops were present at the meeting. Jane introduced Andria Niles from the Sparkly Elephant Sewing Lounge in Friendswood. Andria is a member of the Gulf Coast Modern Quilt Guild. This shop offers classes, an open sewing space, machine rental and sells fabric. The Sparkly Elephant Sewing Lounge uses Facebook and Instagram on social media. Jane introduced Cheryl from Teo's Treasures in Dickinson. This shop offers many fabrics, offers classes including beginner classes on Thursday nights. They sell Martelli tables and rulers, carry Schmetz needles and Aurifil thread. Jane introduced Ronda Stockton from the shop and retreat center And Sew It Began in LaPorte. This shop started as a retreat center. They offer a lot of reproduction fabrics in their shop, but also carry bright colored fabrics. Jane introduced Kaye Shelton from Katie B's in Mont Belvieu. This shop opened in April 2020 during the middle of the pandemic. The shop offers fabrics and many sewing supplies, and offers sew-a-longs, a collage club and classes. There will be a big sale in the shop on January 18th. Members had a chance to 'visit' each of the shops at the meeting.

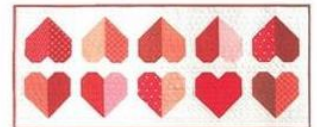
