May Election Training/Equipment Update – Hillary shared that the only item on the May ballot is a DeTour School district proposal. Chippewa County has not received the updated voting equipment and will use the current equipment for the May election. Hillary shared that she has been in contact with the County Clerk to schedule election training in April for anyone interested in renewing their certification or new election workers.

Dump Day- Community Clean Up will be held Saturday, June 16 this year.

RECREATION COMMITTEE

Treadmill Purchase – Leslie shared that a total of \$650 was raised with the can drive. A ProForm treadmill will be purchased for use in the community exercise room. The board thanks Leslie and Taylor for all of their work as well as everyone who donated cans to the cause.

FIRE DEPARTMENT REPORT

There were no runs in February. The snowmobile race fundraiser was very successful with 253 sleds registered for the event. Profit was approximately \$4700. Belfor Corp attended the race and brought 15 SCBA units with 20 spare tanks. These units are valued at about \$4500 each. Raber Bay Outfitters held their annual coyote hunt and donated the proceeds to the Children’s Fund in the amount of \$200. The fire dept would like to thank the participants and Robert Warner of Raber Bay Outfitters for the donation.
