# INHF Launches Scholarship for High School Seniors!

Triangle North Healthcare Foundation (TNHF) has established a scholarship program to help North Carolina high school students in the TNHF region attend college.

Each high school in the TNHF region, which includes Franklin, Granville, Vance, and Warren counties, can nominate one student for the TNHF scholarship. The TNHF Scholarship Committee will select one individual from each county, from the pool provided by the high schools, to receive a \$10,000 scholarship.

Preference will be given to students who plan to major in a health-related field. whose educational goals align with the mission and vision of Foundation. Scholarship applications must be submitted to the school counselors by March 11, 2022.

#### Applicant Qualifications:

- ·Must have a minimum unweighted GPA of 2.5.
- ·Plans to pursue a career in a health -related field
- ·Must be a fulltime resident of Franklin, Granville, Vance, or Warren County.
- ·Will provide a letter of acceptance into an accredited two-year or four-year college or university

- ·Student contact information
- ·High school information and current GPA
- ·Community and extracurricular activities
- ·College information and student essay
- ·Two references-- one academic and one community/personal

## How the Scholarship Works:

- ·Scholarship awards will be announced in the Spring
- ·Funds will be paid directly to the college/university business office.
- ·Scholarship payments will be administered in 2, \$5000 payments
- ·Funds may be used for tuition, room, board, books.
- ·Recipient must be in good standing at the end of the first semester
- •Transcript of first semester is required to receive the 2nd payment of \$5,000
