Format

Qualifying Rounds: There will be two (2) Qualifying Rounds each consisting of five (5) games. Round One will use a “short” lane sport pattern. Round Two will use a “long” lane sport pattern. The top twelve (12) U20 boys, top six (6) U20 girls, the top six (6) U15 boys and the top six (4 or 6) U15 girls, based on the total ten (10) games bowled in the two Qualifying Rounds will advance to the Championship Round on Sunday, May 20th. The final number of advancers to the Championship Round may change based on attendance in each division and any changes will be announced on site. Ties for the last advancer in each division to the Championship Round will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.

Championship Round: The Championship Round will consist of twelve (12) games in which the U20 boys will bowl each U20 boy once and the U20 girls, U15 boys, and U15 girls will bowl each bowler in their division once in head-to-head match play. The Championship Round will use a “medium” lane sport pattern. The winner of each game will receive thirty (30) bonus pins added to their score (15 pins for a tie). The final game in the Championship Round will be a position round. There will be a break after six (6) games.

Tournament Champion: The total pins rolled by a bowler in the ten (10) Qualifying Round games, added to the total pins rolled in the Championship Round games, plus the individual game “bonus” pins earned by a bowler in the Championship Round will determine the tournament champion.

Awards: The end-of-season Championship Tournament SMART scholarship awards are funds collected from tournament entry fees throughout the 2017-2018 season. Go to the *End-of-Season Scholarship Fund* tab on www.jtba.com to view updated award totals for this tournament.

All bowlers that advance to the Championship Round will be awarded a SMART scholarship.
