I've got your back...

We spend so much time on our quilt tops sometimes the backing takes second fiddle, but should it? After all, the backing rests against a person's body, keeping them warm and snug. Before you make a final decision on your backing, here are some things you may want to consider:


Flannel makes a nice backing for lap quilts. The material helps to keep the quilt from sliding off of your lap.

Give some thought to the weight of quilt you would like... will the quilt be used to curl up with a book on a breezy summer day? Build a fort in the livingroom? Or used to ward off the chills in the dead of winter? Minky is so cozy but it may not be the right backing for a summer quilt. Is it a baby quilt and will be washed over and over? Make sure to use the right fabric for your project.

Depending on the size of your quilt (or your artist flare!), you may have to / want to piece the backing. If you are going to quilt it on a longarm, take into account where the seams will be. Vertical seams will start to build up on the roller bars and cause distortion.

There are some really nice wide-width fabrics on the market as well!

Speed Date with Improv with Krista Hennebury

Fri - June 21 and Sat June 22 9:00 am - 4:00 pm \$190.00 for members (\$220.00 for non-members)



Think of this class as speed dating with improvisational piecing techniques that include curves and free- cutting. It will be fast-paced and a lot of fun: several techniques are introduced and demonstrated one after the other with very little time to second guess, stress or obsess

over perfection. Every student will end up with a unique, original quilt! The focus here is to explore line, shape and happenstance in abstract design, so

keep things simply graphic by using solid-coloured fabrics in black, white and one pop of colour. On the second day, we'll work together on the design wall to jigsaw the improv elements together, seeking balance and creative design opportunities. There may even be some time to start with your quilting....depending on the size you choose to make your piece. Some pre-cutting may be required.



Quarter Round with Krista Hennebury

Sun June 23 9:00 am - 4:00 pm \$95.00 for members (\$125.00 for non-members)

This is a modern log cabin variation design with exciting possibilities! This quilt has a multitude of design possibilities for secondary pattern and colour play. Workshop covers accurate cutting, perfecting a scant 1/4" seam allowance, accurate piecing without pins and design wall support with fellow students. A colouring page is sent in advance if students wish to plan their quilt before class.



Quick and Easy Chicken Parmesan Casserole



Ingredients

- 1 Box of frozen, breaded boneless chicken breasts (usually there's about 6-8 breasts in the box)
- 2 jars of ready-made pasta sauce
- 2-3 cups of grated cheeses (cheddar, mozza, whatever you like)

Parsley to garnish when done.

Directions

- 1. Use a baking dish to fit the chicken.
- 2. Take a jar of the pasta sauce and pour over half the sauce, then add water to fill up the jar (which would be half a jar of water) shake to mix the sauce and water and pour over the rest of the chicken.
- 3. Repeat with the second jar.
- 4. Bake this in the over uncovered for about 1 hour, at 350 degrees.
- 5. After this sprinkle over the cheese and bake another 15 min till cheese gets bubbly. You can broil the cheese to brown it up if you want.

Garnish with parsley, and serve with hot buttered noodles, and a salad.

*I sometimes use breaded boneless chicken tenders too.




