Rules and Regulations of the 2018 Cole's Hope Foundation Associate Degree Scholarship

Students who meet eligibility requirements agree to the following terms and conditions by providing a signature on the appropriate line below.

This scholarship funds up to 64 credit hours, fees and textbooks for students attending and seeking an Associate Degree or Certificate program through Jefferson College in Missouri for a total not to exceed \$8,920.00. The degree or certificate sought must be provided through Jefferson College. If you are a recipient of this scholarship, required additional forms with detailed degree seeking information will be provided. All forms must be turned in before any funds can be disbursed. Recipients also agree to fill out a yearly survey pertaining to the scholarship.

Classes Covered: (\$6,720 allotted – 64 credit hours @ \$105.00 per hour)

- 1. Students must be enrolled into Jefferson College prior to June of 2018.
- 2. Students must enroll in a 2-year Associate Degree seeking program for Fall 2018 and enroll as a full-time student in each subsequent semester thereafter (excluding summer) until the requirements are met for the intending Associate Degree or Certificate.
- 3. The classes in which the student enrolls must apply towards the intending Associate Degree/Certification in order to be covered.
- 4. Students must receive a passing grade that counts towards your degree in order for that class to be covered under the 2018 Associate Degree Scholarship.

Textbooks: (\$1,200 allotted - \$300 per semester and any leftover monies from Lab Fees)

1. Only textbooks required/needed for the classes that apply towards the intending degree/certificate will be covered under the Associate Degree Scholarship for a total up to \$1,200.

Lab Fees & Misc. Fees (\$1,000 allotted – if not all \$1,000 is needed for fees, these funds can be applied towards textbooks)

- 1. Required lab fees associated with enrolled classes for the intending Associate Degree/Certificate will be covered under the Associate Degree Scholarship.
- 2. Required enrollment and processing fees will be covered under the Associate Degree Scholarship.
