The month of May includes three public holidays in France:

May 1 is Labour Day (Fête du Travail) which originally commemorated the 1866 labor union strike in Chicago which turned into a violent riot due to an attack by anarchist. The event unfortunately resulted in many protestors being killed. The holiday is also referred to as May Day, and in addition to commemorating all workers, it is entwined with Spring traditions in France, especially those featuring the flowers, Lilies of the Valley.

May 8 is Victory Day which commemorates the end of World War II (in Europe) on that date in 1945, and the victory of Allied Forces over Germany and its Axis ally Italy. Throughout much of Europe, Victory in Europe Day (or VE Day) is a day of remembrance as well as celebration. In France there are memorial services, laying wreaths at military monuments, parades and rekindle of the flame under the Arc de Triomphe.

May 30 is Ascension Day, the Christian holiday that is celebrated on the Thursday, 40 days after Easter Sunday. In additional to religious services, many French peacefully enjoy the Spring weather in outdoor spaces, with some communities organizing sporting or other festive events.
