Faithful is he that calleth you, who also will do it.


Brethren, pray for us.

THE DEVIL

Adversary of God and the main reason for all the trouble associated with the human race. Do not underestimate his power and ability but thanks be to Jesus we can overcome

all his attempts to destroy us.

In this article I want to focus on his origin; his course or progress through the years; and his final end. Simon Peter paints a word picture in the First Epistle chapter 5 verses 8 and 9. I use this as a starting point: (8) "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour: (9) Whom resist steadfast in the faith, knowing that the same afflictions are accomplished in your brethren that are in the world." Some may not wish to acknowledge the devil, but he is active in world affairs and in every human life he can control.

Where did the devil come from? Isaiah 14:12-15 "(12) How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which did weaken the nations! (13) For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: (14) I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. (15) Yet thou shalt be

brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit."

Ezekiel 28:13-18, "(13) Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapplire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created. (14) Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. (15) Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity wasfound in thee. (16) By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence and thou hast sinned: therefore I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, O covering cherub, from the midst of the stones of fire. (17) Thine heart was lifted up because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee. (18) Thou has defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee."

The devil's original name was Lucifer. He was in good standing in God's kingdom. Somehow he aspired to be above God. He was beautiful and held an important place in God's activity i.e. the covering cherub. He walked midst the stones of fire and was covered with precious stones even being in Eden, the garden of God. Because of his attempt to exalt himself above God, he was cast out of all this glory, honor, and beauty. It is hard to imagine this but this is the beginning of the devil, originally Lucifer, high ranked in God's kingdom: now the prime adversary of God and the

human race.

There was no higher place for him to go, so when he was kicked out of God's kingdom he had to go down. He became prince and power of the air; or inhabits that realm between earth (where humans live) and God's throne (which is in existance in outer space). Ephesians 2:2 "Wherein in time past ye walked according to the course of this world, according to the prince of the power of the air, the spirit that now worketh in the children of disobedience." We have to go through this space or air with our prayers to reach God's throne. This is the reason it is hard to pray at times. This is the reason the answers to our prayers are delayed. The devil does all he can to hinder human beings from reaching God's throne through Jesus Christ and delaying the answer to our prayers. Daniel 10:10-14 tells that the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood, Daniel's prayer being answered, for one and twenty days. Here the devil is called the Prince of

In Revelations 12:10 the devil is known as being the accuser of the brethren. He had access and ability to accuse God's children at the throne of God.

Matthew 4:1-11 He was able to tempt Christ who overcame him by the word of God.

Ephesians 6:12 plainly states "We wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers. against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places." This places the devil with access to God's throne as an accuser and with access to earth to bring trouble to God's prime creation: man and woman. The devil has occupied this space between man and God since the time he was kicked out of God's kingdom until now. He will occupy this space until Revelations 12:7-12 becomes a reality. "(7) And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, (8) And prevailed not: neither was their place found any more in heaven. (9) And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. (10) And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the Kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. (11) And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. (12) Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitors of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time."

The time of the devil ruling the heaven between here and God's throne will come to a halt when Michael and his angels fight the dragon or devil and his angels in space. A battle of spirits. I can find no prophecies to be fulfilled before this takes place so I conclude it could happen at any time. The stage is set for such action with the news media talk of UFOs or unidentified foreign objects in space. Just what will happen is a mystery. Since it will be a battle between invisible spirits, it could hardly be noticed by we humans. On the other extreme it could cause happenings in space that would baffle scientists and scare we humans. The ultimate effect will be the devil and his angels will be put out of space and confined to the earth — again another put down. Verse 12 speaks of woe to the inhabitors of the earth and sea, for the devil is come down unto you having great wrath because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.

This could usher in the great tribulation period and the anti-Christ as the devil tries one last time to bring havoc to God's prime creation, man. Some man will allow the devil to take him over and become the anti-Christ, a substitute for

the real Messiah.

Revelations 20:1-3 "(1) And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. (2) And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan and bound him a thousand years. (3) And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.' The next progression of the Devil after being confined to the earth, and this will happen about the time of the Battle of Armageddon, will be to be cast into the bottomless pit by the angel and bound with a great chain with the bottomless pit sealed with the seal of Almighty God to contain him a thousand years.

Jesus will return to this earth, fight the Battle of Armageddon alone, and win, go into the eastern gate and rule the earth for one thousand years. A rule of righteousness with the deceptive Devil contained in the

bottomless pit during that time.

Revelations 20:7-9 "(7) And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison, (8) And shall go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle: the number of whom is as the sand of the sea. (9) And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them."

Do not underestimate the power of the devil. After one thousand years righteous reign with Christ he was able to deceive humans enough to try and take over Christ's kingdom. God ended that by devouring them with fire.

Revelations 20:10 "And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night

forever and ever."

This is the final destination of the devil. His progress has been continually down to end in a devil's hell or lake of fire and brimstone. We have followed his course from an angel - Lucifer - to the devil - prince and power of the air down on earth to be reincarnated in a man who becomes the anti-Christ — to the bottomless pit — to be loosed a season and then to the lake of fire and brimstone.

There are just two ways to go: one with God, His Son Jesus, and the Holy Ghost - one with the devil, false prophet, and his angels. We are given the right of choice. Everyone must make this choice themselves. There is no choosing for someone else. Joshua said, "I set before you life and death; good and evil, choose ye this day whom ye will serve. As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord."

God will not send anyone to the devil's lake of fire. Neither will he make anyone go to heaven. We have to choose. So in real essence I decide my destiny. You decide your destiny. If you insist on going to the devil's lake of fire — I cannot stop you. The choice is yours. As for me and my house (this earthen vessel) we will serve the Lord. I want my destiny to be the inheritance Christ purchased. I'd love to have you go with me. Choosing the devil as master is a losing proposition any way you look at it.

In his book, "A Doctor At Calvary," noted French surgeon Dr. Pierre Barbet says, "The physiological cause of Christ's death was asphyxia. Cramps began in the forearms and spread to the arms and throughout the body. To relieve the cramps, the crucified One pulled Himself up on the footrest or on the nails. The cramps spread to the muscles that control breathing. The lungs, which were filled with air, were unable to expel it. The lungs were caught in a state of forced inspiration, and unable to empty themselves, so the normal oxygenation of the circulating blood was unable to take place. Asphyxiation began as thoroughly as if He had been strangled.'

Christ also died of a broken heart: "Reproach hath broken


my heart; and I am full of heaviness" (Ps. 69:20).



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"...When the children of Israel were gone forth out of the land of Egypt...and were come to the desert of Sinai, and had pitched in the wilderness; and there Israel camped before the mount. And Moses went up unto God, and the Lord called unto him out of the mountain, saying, Thus shalt thou say to the house of Jacob, and tell the children of Israel; Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and how I bare you on eagles wings, and brought you unto myself. Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine: And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests and an holy nation." Exodus 19:1-6a. Verse 5 has the condition upon which this promise was made, "If ye will obey my voice indeed and keep my covenant." God wished to have a people He could mold into a a holy nation, a nation of whom He could be their God and they would be His people. When Moses told them God's message, "...all the people answered together, and said, All that the Lord hath spoken we will do." Exodus 19:8a. Soon after this Moses went up into the mountain and God gave him the laws by which Israel was to be governed. During the time upon Sinai, God also outlined the order of the Levitical priesthood. Moses' brother, Aaron and his sons were chosen to be the priests. Aaron was clothed with the special garments meant only for the high priest while his sons were clothed with garments befitting the priesthood to serve directly under the high priest. They were all to serve in the tabernacle of the congregation and at the altar in the Holy Place. Exodus 28. then in Numbers 3:6-8 we can read where God chose the tribe of the Levites to minister unto Aaron and his sons and to keep the tabernacle and all its instruments clean.

The priests were not chosen by the people nor self appointed but were born into the priestly family. They were well educated in the laws of God but could not become a priest before the age of thirty years. This age also applied to the Levites, Numbers 41:43, 47. Ezekiel was already in captivity when he became thirty years of age. He was of the priestly family yet was taken captive with others in Babylons second group of captives. In Ezekiels thirtieth year he was by the river Chebar, among his fellow workers when God called him to be His prophet to the captive Israelites. John was about thirty years old when he was baptizing people in the Jordan river. "...Now when all the people were baptized, it came to pass, that Jesus also being

baptized, and praying, the heaven was opened, and the Holy Ghost descedned in a bodily shape like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art My beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased. And Jesus Himself began to be about thirty years of age." Luke 3:21-23a. In the Levitical priesthood any man having a physical defect was rejected from serving in an official manner, he could only do tasks which did not necessitate his being at the altar. He allowed to eat of the showbread, (Exodus 21:17-21) and was supported the same as other priests and the Levites from the tithes and offerings from the rest of the Israelite nation.

The writer of Hebrews tells us in chapter 7:1,2 of another Priest who is King of Righteousness and King of Peace. Then we read in verse 6 this Priest is not descended from the Levitical priesthood. "But He whose descent is not counted from them received tithes of Abraham, and blessed him that had the promises. And without all contradiction the less is blessed of the better, and here men that die receive tithes; but there He receiveth them, of them it is witnessed that He liveth." Hebrews 7:6-8. We can also read in Psalm 110-4, "The Lord hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest forever after the order of Melchizedeck." These scriptures bring to our attention the order of the priesthood of which Christ is the High Priest. He was not a Levite but is a Priest after the order of Melchizedic. This verse is quoted six times in Hebrews and each time brings to our attention that the order of the priesthood of Christ is not only different but is superior to the order of the Aaronic priesthood. It does not depend on human lineage but is antecedent to the Aaronic priesthood. The function of the Aaronic priesthood was to offer the sin offerings and sacrificial lambs for the people, "But in those sacrifices there is a rememberance again made of sins every year. For it is impossible that the blood of bulls and of goats should take away sins" Hebrews 10:3,4. But when Jesus came and offered Himself as the sacrificial Lamb, He was not only an offering for sin but also our sanctification. "Then said He, Lo. I come to do they will, O God. He taketh away the first, that He may establish the second. By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all. And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins: But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; " Hebrews 10:9-12. In this He not only became our High Priest but He inaugurated the Royal priesthood. I Peter 2:9 tells about this Royal priesthood, "But ye are a chosen generation, a Royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people: that ye should show forth the praises of Him who hath called you out of darkness into His marvelous light."

A Priest of the Levitical priesthood must be an example unto the people and follow certain restrictions placed upon his conduct which may not have been placed upon the people as a whole. As a member of the holy nation and the priesthood under the leadership of Christ there are some restrictions placed upon our conduct also. Let us look at some of the comparisons of the two priesthoods. The Levitical priest had to be born into the priestly family. Before we can be a part of the Royal priesthood Peter was talking about, we have to be a member of that holy nation, (both the nation and the priesthood are mentioned in I Peter 2:9). This requires a "born again" experience. It was purchased for us through Jesus death upon the cross also. Jesus talked about this experience when He was talking to Nicodemus, John 3:3. We cannot attain a membership into

this holy nation without holiness which comes through the new birth. To become holy we must consecrate or give ourselves unto God then He accepts that gift and sets us apart for His service. This is called sanctification. God officially makes us a part of His church. Christ loves the church "...and gave Himself for it; that He might sanctify and cleanse it with the washing of water by the word. That He might present it to Himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish." Ephesians 5:25b-27. James 1:27 also says, "Pure religion and undefiled before God is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world" As a part of the Royal priesthood we have the responsibility to keep ourselves pure. The Levitical priest had to cleanse himself daily. We too though we have been thoroughly cleansed through the blood of Christ we must examine ourselves daily to be sure we have not let the things of the world spot our conduct or our lives as a result of walking among the people of the world from day to day. We must stay pure in the service of the Lord.

The Levitical priest was required to wear certain clothing. The christian priest must also be clothed with the proper clothing. Paul discribes the clothing of the christian as that of a soldier ready for battle when he says to put on the whole armour of God. Ephesians 6:11-18. We need to especially look at the phrase "having on the breastplate of righteousness" in verse 14. In Isaiah 59:17 God is pictured as putting on "Righteousness as a breastplate and an helmet of salvation upon His head." Righteousness should not be looked upon as a status man has before God it is the life of purity in our relationship with Christ. Barclay says, "When a man is clothed in righteousness, he is impregnable. Words are no defense against accusations, but a good life is." Dale remarks, "A pure heart resents with disgust and scorn the first approaches of temptation to purity." Yielding to sin is cowardly while bravery and courage come from right thinking. Revelation 1:5c-6 says, "Unto Him who loved us, and washed us from our sins in His own blood, And hath made us kings and priests unto God and His father; for ever and ever. Amen." It is this body of kings and priests who will make up that Royal priesthood and holy nation to be called God's church, and become the bride at the marriage supper of the Lamb. "Let us be glad and rejoice, and give honour unto Him: for the marriage of the Lamb is come, and His wife hath made herself ready. And to her was granted that she should be arrayed in fine linen, clean and white: for the fine linen is the righteousness of saints." Revelation

In the Levitical priesthood a priest found it mandatory to make a wise choice of whom he married. It was unlawful for him to marry a prostitute, a woman who was not spiritual in her interest or a divorcee. His wife must be of good report among the people and not do anything that would bring reproach upon his ministry, Leviticus 21:7. The Christian priest also must repect God's words in respect to his conduct. I Timothy 3:1-13 is very explicit about the conduct of the christian worker. Remember, Jesus is our High Priest. The Ministers or preachers become the same as the sons of Aaron. I Timothy 3:1 calls them bishops. Verses 2,3,7 of the same chapter say, "A bishop then must be blameless, the husband of one wife, vigilant, sober, of good behavior, given to hospitality, apt to teach; Not given to wine, no striker, not greedy of filthy lucre; but patient, not a brawler, not covetous. Moreover he must have a good report of them which are without; lest he fall into reproach." These verses give a guideline for both husband and wife in the ministry. The wife must still compliment her husbands ministry. Though there are no specific words in these verses concerning the conduct of the wife, we must still remember God made woman to an helpmate to her husband, Genesis 2:18. Now we come to the rest of the Christian priesthood. In the Levitical priesthood they were the Levites and they were the helpers to Aaron's sons. In I Timothy 3:8 they are called deacons. All dedicated, consecrated Christians belong to this group. Verses 8,9 and 12 mention qualifications for "Likewise must the deacons be grave, not doubletongues, not given to much wine, not greedy of filthy lucre; holding the mystery of the faith in a pure conscience. Let the deacons be the husbands of one wife, ruling their children and their own houses well." Then verse 11 mentions some qualifications for the wives. "Even so must their wives be grave, not slanderers, sober, faithful in all things." It is only natural the wives of bishops are also bound by the same

Now we come to the behavior of the children of the Christian family. I Timothy 3:4,12 mentions the children also. They are to be in subjection to their parents. Ephesians 6:1 says, "Children, obey your parents in the Lord: for this is right." But then we find some more advice in verse 6 where we read, "And ye fathers (and mothers), provoke not your children to wrath; but bring them up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord." To rule one's house with all gravity is so much more than just giving out orders and dealing out harsh punishments. It is also more than just handing the children everything they could wish for in things which are not necessities. It means to give understanding, showing compassion, showing the way of right and wrong by the way we live before them, teaching them in gentleness. emember, they are children and must be allowed to understand with a childs mind. When they get an adult's understanding they will be adults.

The christian priesthood is a holy nation made up of christians of a mixed multitude from around the world. As a holy nation unto God, He has set us apart for His service. that service unto God is to herald the good tidings of God's love to all who will hear, wherever or whoever they are. We should not disire to be like those around us in attitudes and actions but must be an example of the One who gave His very life's blood as a ransom for all. Peter calls us a peculiar people. Today we think of peculiar meaning odd or strange but when Peter used it, he was writing in Greek and the translation of the Greek would say we are a purchsed people. We have been purchased by the blood of Christ and are a unique possession of God. We read in I Peter 1:15, "But as He which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation."conversation as used here means all manner of life. Notice we are not to "become holy as life progresses but we are to show holiness in every thing we do. This is possible in our day! the same God who has supplied the power of holiness for others has made it available for all who will seek it. The key to our obtaining this spiritual power to strengthen us in purity of character and conduct is to take time to be holy. a verse from the hymn by Wm. D. Longstaff tells us:

Take time to be holy, The world rushes on; Spend much time in secret with Jesus alone, By looking to Jesus, like Him thou shalt be; Thy friends in thy conduct His likeness shall see.

CLARENCE THEODORE SHEPHERD was born to Theodore and Emma (Rounds) Shepherd on December 5, 1895 near Aline, Oklahoma and at an early age he moved with his mother to Rogers, Arkansas. He departed this life Saturday, September 3, 1983 at his home in Perryton. He was 87.

He was always interested in science and spent all his spare time in the lab. Working his way thru high school, he was employed as a mechanic's helper in a local garage. He took his first car ride in 1909 from Liberal to Hugoton, Kansas.

Clarence registered for the Army in World War I at Augusta, Kansas, but never served. As a young man, he worked for Wells Fargo in Augusta and Cheney, Kansas.

On February 29, 1920, Clarence was united in marriage to Maggie Whitaker and to this union five children were born.

In 1931, Clarence accepted Christ as his personal Savior and lived an exceptional, dedicated Christian life, serving as Full Gospel Church treasurer for 25 years and teaching a Sunday School class for several years.

In 1923, Shep (as he was known) opened up the garage business in Perryton. In 1949, he moved from Ash Street to the present location, 300 West Main. Shep was known for miles around for his conscious labor on magnetos, starters and electric motors. The philosophy on which he made his business a success for the past sixty years was: "Live and let live".

He was preceded in death by one infant son; another son, Charles Preston; a daughter, Mrs. Wanda DeArmound; a step-son; Lenard Whitaker; his parents and step-mother; and his loving and devoted wife, Maggie.

He leaves to mourn his passing his daughters, Mrs. Martin (Daisy) Eagan of Central Point, Oregon; Mrs. Roy (Blanche) Davison of Hedley, Texas; Mrs. H. T. (June) Sutherland of Wichita, Kansas and Mrs. Bob (Hazel) Taylor of Logan, Oklahoma; 11 grandchildren; 29 great-grandchildren; 24 great-grandchildren; nieces, nephews, other relatives and a host of friends.

Bylaws of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, Inc.

ARTICLEVII

Doctrine

It is recognized that the true church of Jesus Christ consists of all believers in the saving grace of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ who have accepted him as their personal Saviour. It is recognized and agreed that no organization or man has been granted authority by the Lord to exclude from or accept anyone into the Kingdom of Heaven, as this is done by Jesus Christ only. It is further recognized and agreed that we as Christians are to love all members of the Body of Christ (Christians), and this love and fellowship derives from the unity instilled by the Holy Spirit. Although differences in doctrinal beliefs and interpretations should not influence our love for one another, adherence to similar doctrinal beliefs and modes of worship have bonded together those of the Apostolic Faith Movement as founded by Charles F. Parham in the early 1900's. The scripture teaches us to adhere to the truth and proper doctrine. The common doctrinal beliefs are essentially as follows:

Triune God; Father, Son and Holy Spirit

Creation and Formation

Man is basically sinful and in need of Salvation

Salvation by Grace upon repentance toward God and acceptance of Jesus Christ as one's personal Saviour, which is the conception of Spiritual Life.

Sanctification of the Spirit, Soul and Body. A second

definite work of Grace by the Lord Jesus Christ.

Baptism of the Holy Spirit; evidenced by speaking in other languages.

Water Baptism (of all believers) by immersion in water in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Sacrament of the Lord's Supper.

Washing of Feet.

Divine Healing through Jesus Christ for all believers.
Do not condone divorce and remarriage. Matthew 19:8-9.

Destruction of the Wicked.

Conditional Immortality.

Rapture of the Man Child Class.

Return of Jesus Christ to earth again; bodily and visibly.

A Ministry supported by tithes and offerings.

These basic doctrines shall be adhered to in the teaching of the Apostolic Faith Bible College, which in addition to other doctrinal teaching approved by the Board from time to time if they are not inconsistent with the above listed basic doctrines.
