

E911 The addressing grid that is the basis for the Chippewa County Uniform Addressing System originates in the southwest corner of the county and extends out toward the northeast corner of the county. The grid is similar to an X/Y coordinate system. • 1000 potential resident/business addresses per mile •500 potential addresses on each side of the road per mile •An address can be assigned every 5.28ft Avenue (AV) Addresses

Traveling East, the address numbers will get larger Traveling West, the address numbers will get smaller The North side of the road has even number addresses The South side of the road has odd number addresses Street (ST) Addresses

Traveling North, the address numbers will get larger

Traveling South, the address numbers will get smaller

The West side of the road has even number addresses

The East side of the road has odd number addresses

County Forest ATV Trail Regulations

The Chippewa County Forest ATV Trail and associated routes are ypically open from May 1st to November 15th.

No off-trail operation is allowed. Violators will be prosecuted. All rules and regulations listed in "Wisconsin All-Terrain Vehicle

Laws" DNR publication Pub-LE-500 2014 apply. All motorcycles are prohibited from operating on the County Forest ATV Trail. UTV's are allowed on the County Forest ATV Trail and associated

outes. UTV's are defined as a motor-driven vehicle that does not neet federal motor vehicle standards; that is not a golf cart, ow-speed vehicle, dune buggy, mini-truck, or tracked vehicle; that s designed to be used primarily off of a highway; that has, and was originally manufactured with, all the following:

• net weight of less than 2,000lbs • four or more low pressure tires

 cargo box · steering wheel • tail light

 brake lights two headlights

• max width of 65 inches • non-straddled seats for at least two people

 seat belts for each occupant • roll bar or similar structural system or device

ATV's and UTV's may not operate on any route or trail within the County Forest during shooting hours of the regular gun deer season.
