Theory Class 1 Tuesday 26th July
 5.30pm – 8.30pm

On your first day we will cover the principals of hygiene, expand your mind with colour theory and different textures. Learn about the different skin types and how to best prepare the skin before applying a flawless foundation.

Practical Class 1 Thursday 28th July
 5.30pm-8.30pm
 Practical application – No Models are required for this class.

Theory Class 2 Tuesday 2nd August
 5.30pm – 8.30pm
 Today we will learn about different face shapes and the methods behind contouring and highlighting. Application of blush and bronzer and we will cover how to use corrective techniques using colour theory. You will have perfected foundation colour matching and application by today.

Practical Class 2 Thursday 4th August
 5.30pm-8.30pm
 Practical application – models with an interesting face shape are needed today.

Theory Class 3 Tuesday 9th August
 5.30pm – 8.30pm
 Prepare to take in a lot of information all about eyes today! We will completely break down the different techniques in changing and enhancing the multiple types of eye shapes. Learning about definition and development of eyebrows as well as learning the difference between a classic eye and a smokey eye.

Practical Class 3 Thursday 11th August
 5.30pm-8.30pm
 Practical application – Try find a model with a different eye shape for every practical session from today onwards. Try to find someone with an almond eye shape today.

Theory Class 4 Tuesday 16th August
 5.30pm – 8.30pm
 We will learn everything there is to know about lips and lip shapes today. We will discuss the different combinations of eye and lip looks. You will find that after today's session you will be more confident in completing makeup looks, piecing each feature together to create a balanced artwork. Today is also LASH DAY!

Practical Class 4 Thursday 18th August
 5.30pm-8.30pm
 Practical application – Find a model that has a balanced lip shape and round doe eyes. Make sure your model does not have sensitive eyes, as you will be applying lashes today.

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Theory Class 5 Tuesday 23rd August

5.30pm – 8.30pm

Today is divided into two topics. In the morning we will discuss mature aged makeup - Appropriate levels of makeup required and dealing with a different skin texture. The second part of theory will be about dealing with different skin tones, darker skin tones and different ethnicity.

Practical Class 5 Thursday 25th August

5.30pm-8.30pm

Practical application – Try find a model with a different skin tone or who has a few fine lines. Challenge yourself in this class, as it is an opportunity for you to learn!

Theory Class 6 Tuesday 30th August

5.30pm – 8.30pm

Today is bridal day! We will spend time talking about the different types of bridal looks available, how to run an effective business as a freelance artist focussed on bridal work. We will cover the application of makeup needed for different lighting and photography. Today we will revisit Lashes! Different types, textures and shapes can be used to create different effects.

Practical Class 6 Thursday 1st September

Practical application – Find a model who you would love to create a bridal look on. Preferably someone who does not have sensitive eyes, as we will be applying lashes today. (Make sure your model has somewhere lovely to go after today's class!)
