BOARD OF DIRECTORS

If you are interested in becoming a member of the Board of Directors, you must be a bond-holding member and submit a letter to the President. Information for the process is on the club website under the Board of Directors.

DEEP WATER TESTING

ASC requires that all swimmers ages 14 and under who wish to swim in water deeper than 4 feet pass a water test. Upon passing the test, swimmers' names will be recorded for future reference, and wristbands will be issued permitting them to swim in the deeper areas of the pool.

SNACK BAR HOURS

The Snack Bar will be open 11 AM through 7 PM daily as business and weather dictate. The menu will have some breakfast days and new and healthy items.

FOOD & DRINK AT ASC

We ask that members bringing coolers with food and drink take the coolers to a table in the picnic areas. Picnic tables are in the picnic areas and the snack bar area. Food and drinks (other than bottled water) may not be consumed in the pool area. These items have caused past problems with the filtering system. We ask for your cooperation in trying to keep food and drink off the pool decks, away from the pools and out of the pool filtering system.

Alcoholic beverages are not permitted at Aronimink Swim Club.

POOL CONTAMINATION POLICY

Aronimink Swim Club will adhere to the American Red Cross directive concerning fecal matter in the pools. We will close the affected pool for up to 24 hours. All babies in the baby pool **must** wear rubber pants over their diapers or diapers designed for swimming.

ENTERING POOL GROUNDS

We have a new member database program. Please be patient as we all are new to this. The front office will ask your name and we ask that you wait till they give you the ok to enter. This will take some time in the beginning as your picture that we have on our software is your admittance to the pool.

ACCIDENT REPORTS

Any member or guest of a member who experiences an accident while at the swim club must notify the manager on duty at the time it occurs so that an accident (or incident) report can be filed. Please be sure to let management know immediately.

BATHROOM USE

When using the bathroom, we ask that members wear flip-flops or shoes to protect your feet on the rougher surface. We also ask that parents accompany small children using the bathrooms to prevent any type of accident/injury.

LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSE

A course for the American Red Cross Lifeguard Training will be offered beginning Tuesday, May 31 from 4:30-8:30 p.m. All classes are mandatory on the following dates:

- May 31, June 1, 2, 6, 7, 8, 9, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17
- Classes are 4:30-8:30 PM each night

Any member who is 15-years or older may take the course free of charge; however, students will be responsible for the cost of course materials (\$80; make checks payable to ASC). The American Red Cross requires that anyone wishing to take the course must present a birth certificate as proof of age. Participants who successfully complete the Lifeguarding course receive an American Red Cross certificate for Lifeguarding/First Aid/CPR/AED, valid for 2 years.

ARTS AND CRAFTS

Arts and Crafts will take place on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday afternoons, beginning the last week of June

- 4-6-year-old 1:15 p.m. / 7 & older 2 p.m.
- Starts the last week in June and runs for six weeks

WATER AEROBICS

Water Aerobics classes will begin the week of June 20 and will continue through the season unless otherwise noted. Classes will generally take place on the following days and times:

- Mondays and Wednesdays, 6:30-7:30 p.m.
- Tuesdays and Thursdays, 10:45-11:45 a.m.

PRIVATE SWIMMING LESSONS

If you are interested in private swim lessons for your children ages 3 and above, a lifeguard can provide private swimming lessons. These lessons may be given only on the lifeguards off-time (lifeguards cannot give lessons during a shift for which he or she has responsibilities). The standard rate for private swim lessons is **\$25** per half hour of instruction. Visit the lifeguard office during pool hours to schedule a lesson.

CHILDREN'S GROUP SWIM LESSONS

ASC offers group swim lessons for children ages 5 through 8. Lessons are Monday through Thursday (with Friday reserved as a makeup session due to a weather cancellation). These lessons are designed to promote basic water familiarity and safety with the children; they are not designed for those interested in competitive swimming instruction.

All children taking lessons must pay a \$5 fee. The \$5 fee will be refunded if and only if the child attends all lessons. Sessions for lessons will be as follows:

- Session 1: June 20, 21, 22, 23, 27, 28, 29, 30 [9-9:30 a.m. for ages 5-6; 9:30-10 a.m. for ages 7-8]
- Session 2: July 5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14 [9-9:30 a.m. for ages 5-6; 9:30-10 a.m. for ages 7-8]
- Session 3: July 18, 19, 20, 21, 25, 26, 27, 28 [9-9:30 a.m. for ages 5-6; 9:30-10 a.m. for ages 7-8]

POOL ACCESS RULES – MEMBERS

No one will be allowed into the pool without a paid membership and photos taken. A membership shall include husband, wife, and children or life partners (as defined by the Board of Directors) and children, whose permanent residence is in the same dwelling, regardless of who, in the group, is the actual member. The Board of Directors may (in specific instances) include in the membership others than the above whose residence is in the same dwelling (but, a houseguest pass must be purchased for each person).

- Members Ages 0 – 10 (Must be with adult)
- Members Ages 11-13 (can enter club alone)
- Members Ages 14-17 (may sign in guest)
- Members 18 & Over (Adult Privileges)

GUEST PASS POLICY

Guest passes cost \$10 per guest per day. Guests may live inside or outside of the pool boundaries. A member aged 14 or older must accompany the guest for sign-in at the pool ticket office and stay with the guest the entire time while at the swim club.

HOUSE GUEST – (PRIOR PINK CARD)

A person who is not eligible for membership (but living in the home of a member either permanently or during the pool season) may be eligible to purchase a houseguest pass for \$100 that allows them to access the pool for the season. To qualify, the member must provide a copy of proof of residency (driver's license or if a child, a copy of their parent's driver's license) to the pool. Information should be provided at the pool front office or mailed in with your membership dues. The membership committee will review the information.

2022 SWIM TEAM

If your children are interested in being a member of the 2022 Aronimink Swim Team, there will be a **MANDATORY MEETING** on Tuesday, May 17 at 5:30 PM at the pool. Any boy or girl between the ages of 5 and 18 may sign up for the team. The summer swim team is **NOT** a swim lesson program. Requirements to join the team are below.

To join the team, swimmers ages 10 & under must be able to swim one lap (25 yards) of freestyle (arm over arm) in 40 seconds or less (without stopping or grabbing the wall/lane rope) and must immediately tread water for 1:00. Swimmers ages 11 and up must be able to swim 50 yards freestyle without stopping in 1:20 and must immediately tread water for 1 minute. If your swimmer does not meet the requirements, they will be given the opportunity to join our pre-team practices (more info coming soon).
