Calumet County Youth Sports League Rookie Ball

2023 Rules

Purpose: To promote the game of baseball and provide area youth with the opportunity to develop and learn the game through practice and games.

League Wide Rules:

- 1. Sportsmanship will be encouraged by players, coaches, and fans.
- 2. The league does not carry insurance.
- 3. Players are expected to be properly equipped.
- 4. Players are expected to play for their community. If a player is going to change teams it should be done when they switch levels or players must sit out one year. Hardships can be argued to the league..
- 5. While running bases, any illegal contact will be determined by the coaches and safe or out call will be based on decision.
- 6. Coaches should be informed of league rules prior to each game.
- 7. All games that are postponed will be made up in good faith and a timely manner.
- 8. Games are 6 innings or 1 hour
 - a. Coaches will be official time keeper and will notify of last inning
- 9. 10 players on the field (4 outfielders only) and Min of 8
- 10. Each player MUST play 2 innings in the field
- 11. 5 runs per inning or 3 outs. Whichever comes first
- 12. If a team is up by more than 10 runs after the 4th inning the game will be over(Coaches Discretion)

13. <u>NO STEALING</u>

- 14. Live ball on an overthrow except when ball goes out of the field of play, then it will be only one base.
- 15. Teams WILL bat the full roster-3 outs per inning
- 16. Unlimited substitution and re-entry
- 17. Helmets must be worn at all times inside the fence
- 18. No infield fly rule
- 19. Cannot advance on a drop 3rd strike.

20.All base sliding must be done feet first

- a. Player must slide when play is being made.
- b. If the player doesn't slide when the play is being made, the player is out. Coaches discretion
- 21. Need to have a catcher properly equipped.
- 22. Need to have regular Little League Baseballs

Levels and Specific Rules:

Pitching and Hitting

- a. Batters will receive 5 pitches, unless he/she strikes out swinging. NO TEE WILL BE USED. If after 5 pitches, the batter does not hit the ball he/she will be considered out. If the batter fouls off the 5th pitch it will be considered a foul ball and he/she will get another pitch and will continue to get another pitch if they keep fouling.
- b. A coach from the team that is batting will "pitch". Thrower will be placed on the 40 ft rubber and set at 4 unless both teams agree on another setting. A player acting as the pitcher must stay even with the pitchers rubber and within 5 ft to the left or right of the rubber and not be allowed to stand behind the coach who is pitching. The pitch will not be thrown until the pitcher makes a pitching motion.
- c. The pitching coach cannot field the ball, but if the ball hits the coach, the play is considered dead and declared a do-over. A ball that hits the throwing machine is considered a live ball.
- d. There is no bunting or fake bunting allowed or the batter is automatically out. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- e. For the end of the year tournament it will be \$100 per team given to the host Community.
