The City Council of the City of Vienna met in regular session, Wednesday, March 20, 2019 at Vienna City Hall with the following members and guest:

There being a quorum, Mayor Simmons called the meeting of the Vienna City Council to order at 6:30 p.m.

NEW BUSINESS

Alderman Riddle made a motion to Approve the Omnibus Consent Agenda consisting of the March 6, 2019 Council Meeting Minutes, Treasurer's Report and the Warrant (\$43,510.72). Alderman Racey seconded the motion. Motion carried, 4-yes, 2-absent.

Alderman Owen made a motion to Authorize and Approve \$1,650.00 (TIF Funds) for Facade Application, 406 Court Street, Milkmaid Creations Antiques. The motion was seconded by Alderman Tuey. Motion carried, 4-yes 2-absent.

Clerk reviewed an additional TIF application submitted by Emily Kerley, Milkmaid Creations Antiques with council members. Kerley was present to discuss roof and wall repairs. Wright said this would be on the next meeting's agenda for action.

Alderman Racey made a motion to Authorize and Approve Resolution 19-01, A Resolution establishing fees for the use of park shelters. Alderman Owen seconded the motion. Motion carried, 4-yes 2-absent.

Alderman Tuey made a motion to Authorize and Approve the Zoning's Boards Recommendation to Approve the 2019 Zoning District Map per March 18th hearing. Alderman Riddle seconded the motion. Motion carried, 4-yes 2-absent.

Alderman Owen made a motion to Authorize and Approve Ordinance 19-01, An Ordinance Approving the 2019 Zoning District Map for the City of Vienna, IL. Alderman Racey seconded the motion. Motion carried, 4-yes 2-absent.

Supt Racey discussed bids submitted by Cat Contracting -\$5,975.00 and Mott Excavating, Inc- \$5,800.00 for a cut/cap project to the city's water main.

Alderman Owen made a motion to accept proposal from Mott Excavating for a cut/cap project (\$5,800.00) to the city's water main for IDOT project replacement of Little Cache Creek bridge on highway 45 South. The motion was seconded by Alderman Tuey. Motion carried, 4-yes 2-absent.

CITY ELECTED AND APPOINTED OFFICIALS

Mayor Simmons announced there would be two dog grooming business's opening soon. Simmons also discussed the issue of unkempt yards. Simmons said the city would be issuing warnings to those who needed to clean up their property. Council discussed the upcoming city cleanup Monday, May 6th which would be a good opportunity to do so as the city's trash service would pick up additional items set out.

Clerk Wright discussed upcoming important dates including City Spring Fling Carnival, May 2-4th, City wide trash cleanup May 6th, and the Annual City wide yard sale June 7-8th.

Supt Racey discussed fire hydrants in need of repair. Racey also said the transmission was going out in the city's dump truck and due to the condition of the truck, it was not worth repairing. Racey said he would be looking for a used replacement.

Phil Morris, Depot discussed details of a fundraiser for city Christmas lights organized by Johnson County Revitalization. Morris also talked about the annual 50/100 mile run in which parking passes would be \$5 per car for the weekend event, runners would be notified when signing up about the cost.

Alderman Tuey discussed a USDA grant opportunity with council. Tuey revisited the idea of tornado sirens reviewing past estimates he had obtained through Sentry Sirens. Council had discussion but no action was taken.

As there was no further business to discuss, Mayor Simmons declared the meeting adjourned at 7:42 p.m.
