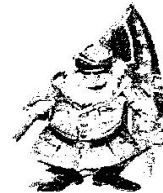

Election Year

Article VII - Officers

Commander, First Lt Commander, Second Lt Commander, Adjutant, Judge Advocate, Quartermaster, Surgeon, Chaplain, Color Sergeant, Historian, and Editor.

Article X - Other Committees
