Cicely Tyson (born December 19, 1924) was an American actress and film producer. She was the first African American woman to win the Academy Award for Best Actress, for her role in the 1976 film "Sound of Music". She was also nominated for the award in 1977 for "Fences" and in 1981 for "The Color Purple". She was a member of the Screen Actors Guild and the Academy of Motion Picture Arts and Sciences.

Kamala Devi Harris
Born October 20, 1964, is an American politician and attorney who is the first South Asian and first woman to be elected vice president of the United States. She is the United States' first female vice president, the highest-ranking female elected official in U.S. history, and the first ethnic American and first Asian American vice president.
A member of the Democratic Party, she served as a United States senator from California from 2017 to 2021, and as the attorney general of California from 2017 to 2019. Harris became vice president upon inauguration in January 2021 alongside President Joe Biden.

He was inducted into the Baseball Hall of Fame in 1982.
