Purpose:

To outline the cadet advisor and associate advisor participation requirements, roles, and responsibilities.

Advisors:

Adult advisors shall be responsible for carrying out a well-rounded program. The following types of advisors are recognized.

- a) **Organization Leader:** The Fire Chief of Largo Fire Rescue. The organization leader has overall control and responsibility for the cadet program.
- b) **Chief Advisor:** The chief advisor is appointed by the organization leader. The chief advisor is a fire department administrative chief who handles the administrative requirement of the cadet program.
- c) **Post Advisor:** The post advisor is appointed by the organization leader. The post advisor is a lieutenant or firefighter at least age 21 or older. The post advisor is responsible for the day-to-day operations of the program.
- d) **Associate Advisor:** Shall be appointed by the post advisor to help with program activities.
- e) **Special Advisor:** May be appointed by the post advisor to head specific areas of the unit.
