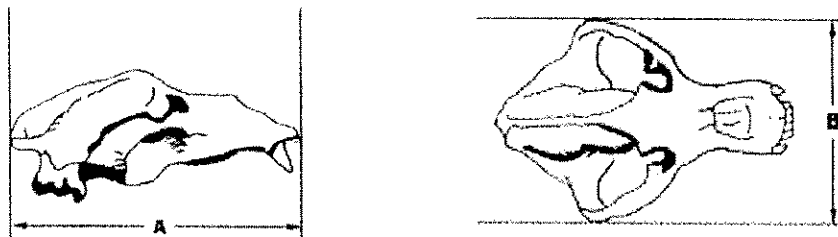
For Example: 21 and 1/2 pound bird with two 5/8" spurs and 9 and 1/2 beard scores 53

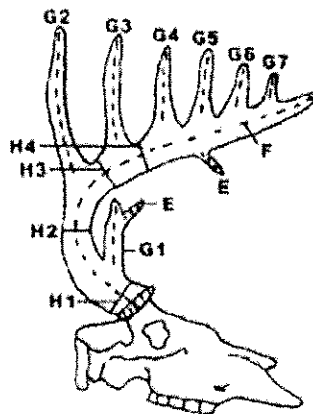
