We will be looking at how many languages are spoken in our year group and thinking about what is a traditional in our homes. We will be learning how to make connections between different events and situations such as; is money the same in all countries? Is there food that we all like to eat or do we eat different things? We will be making homes and thinking about how homes and environments are different in different countries and places. At home, you can talk with your child about the world and environment around them. What do they notice? Are they always the same or are they different? If so how and why? We will be talking about money from home and abroad. Using our numbers to 20 and beyond by adding, subtracting, doubling and halving. Playing shops with your child is a great way for them to learn how to use the money.
