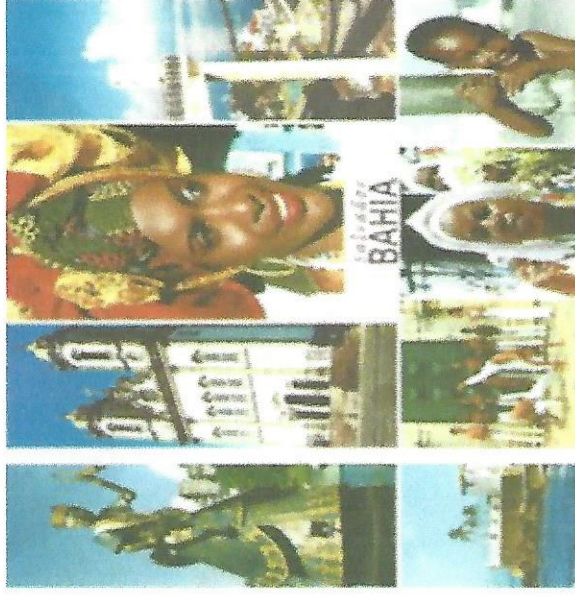

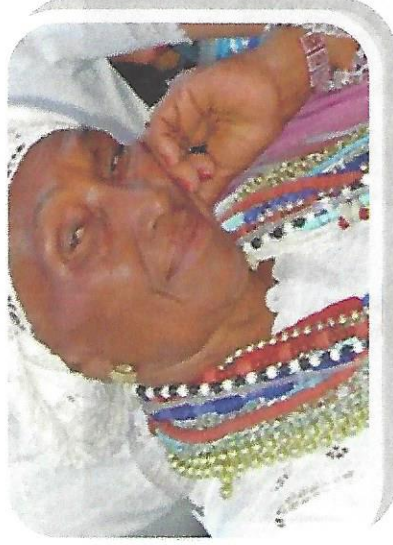


Capoeira and Maculele, ancestral dances that symbolize the freedom of black people in Brazil.
