## 2022 Season Win Total Projections (Power Ratings Only)

In order to come up with a season win total projection, we take the projected spread of each game and figure out a win percentage chance for that game. If you have a 90% chance to win a game, you get credit for 0.9 of a win. If you have a 20% chance to win a game, you get credit for 0.2 of a win. When you add up the win percentages for all 12 games, you get an early season win total projection.

Below is an example for Alabama this year. The Crimson Tide will be favored in all 12 games this year by double digits. Does that mean Alabama's season win total should be close to 12? Not when you do the correct math as you get a season win total of 11.08 for the Crimson Tide.

**1★ Northwestern (+13.5) † Nebraska 30 Northwestern 19.** @ Aviva Stadium in Dublin, Ireland. Last year Nebraska destroyed Northwestern 56-7. However, prior to that outlier performance, Northwestern had covered 7 of the previous 10 meetings since Nebraska joined the Big Ten. Nine of the 10 games were decided by 11 points or less. Obviously, Nebraska was much better than their 3-9 record indicated last year as they actually out-scored their competition on the season. All NINE of their losses were by single-digits! This should be Scott Frost's best team yet but we still have our doubts. Meanwhile, Northwestern is also off a 3-9 season but this year's team should be improved thanks to a solid OL. Pat Fitzgerald's team usually rebound very well off poor seasons. We bet the UNDER a few months ago but feel that value has dried up. We now prefer the disrespected underdog.

**FLORIDA ATLANTIC 32 Charlotte 26.** This is an important CUSA game to start for both teams. Both had bowl expectations last year and both fell short at 5-7. FAU head coach Willie Taggart is not one of our favorites but he does welcome back some Power 5 talent led by QB N'Kosi Perry. Meanwhile Charlotte QB Chris Reynolds returns for what seems like his 10th season as the starter. FAU has won the last 3 meetings including 38-9 last year. We don't see too much value here but if you shop for Charlotte "+7.5", that's worth a pizza bet in our opinion.

**Nevada 29 NEW MEXICO ST 20.** One of the bigger movers of the entire Week 0/1 board on both side and total. We gave out UNDER 55 to VIP customers a couple weeks ago but that value is gone. Believe it or not, Nevada opened as a 17.5-point favorite in May at DraftKings. The Wolf Pack have a new head coach and are one of the least experienced teams in the entire country. On top of that two of their projected starters are out in RT Aaron Frost and FS JoJuan Claiborne. 45 players that were on last year's roster are no longer on the team and Nevada even has a few walk-ons in the two-deep. We have downgraded Nevada more in our power ratings than any team in the country. While New Mexico St also has a new coach in Jerry Kill, we think they'll be improved especially on defense. Safe to say we think this game will be much more competitive than last year where Nevada led 52-7 at one point. However, we don't see a lot of value at the current numbers.

**UTAH ST 41 Connecticut 16.** Connecticut is just 4-37 SU in their last 41 games. They welcome a new coach in Jim Mora Jr who hasn't coached since 2017 at UCLA. The Huskies return 15 starters and should be improved (not saying much). They played a Week Zero game last year out West and were trounced by Fresno St 45-0 but we expect them to be more competitive this season. After a 1-5 2020 season, Utah St comes in off a shocking Mountain West title last year. Blake Anderson did a wonderful job in year one and welcomes back QB Logan Bonner who has been a bit banged up during fall camp. With Alabama on deck, we expect the Aggies to ease into the season. We like the dog and also lean UNDER.

**UTEP 28 North Texas 27.** Another really competitive CUSA match-up to start the season. Bowl teams have bowl aspirations in 2022. We haven't been able to say that much with regards to the UTEP program. However, head coach Dana Dimel has built them the right way and last year's 7-6 record wasn't a fluke. North Texas has won the last 5 meetings but 3 of the last 4 have come by 3 points or less. The match-up to watch is North Texas' powerful run game that has averaged at least 230 rush ypg the last two years vs a UTEP DL that returns all 4 starters and rates as one of the best in CUSA. We bet UTEP and the UNDER here but again with these lines out 3-plus months already, a lot of the value has dried up.

**ILLINOIS 29 Wyoming 16.** Some money has showed up on Illinois this week with this line moving off a key "10". Even with a low total, we agree with the move on the favorite. Wyoming is one of the least experienced teams in the country ranking No. 129 in both Phil Steele's experience chart and Bill Connelly's returning production. The Cowboys saw a lot of their key players transfer out and we question the locker-room chemistry. Both of these teams have similar profiles as they are run-first, play decent defense. Obviously, Illinois has the talent edge and Bielema has been good in season openers (see last year's upset of Nebraska). We lean Illinois.

**Vanderbilt 30 HAWAII 23.** We bet Vanderbilt -2.5 in this game a couple months ago. Earlier this week, a sharper group laid -6.5 and drove the number right past a key "7". Vanderbilt arrived a week early for this game to acclimate to the time change. Clark Lea's team should be improved in year two with 14 returning starters. However, that's not saying much considering they went 2-10 last season that included a 20-point loss to an FCS team. The main reason we've seen the big line move is more of a "play against" Hawaii. The Warriors return only 5 starters and rank near in the bottom 5 of returning production nationally. New head coach Timmy Chang is the all-time leading passer here, but he's never been a coordinator or head coach before. We think Vanderbilt is the right side but can't recommend them at the current price.

# Week 1 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip!** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 8 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Pittsburgh -7**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.
