A MESSAGE FROM WALK #157 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

I attended my original Walk to Emmaus in May of 1999, but I remember it like it was yesterday. Or I should say, I remember the last day like it was yesterday. Like Cleopas and his companion it was far into my walk before I saw the face of Jesus. I remember that the talks were very interesting and challenging. A lot of men were touched, many to the point of tears and I thought that was nice. I remember on Friday around lunch, I'm not sure exactly what time (they had taken my watch), we had a very unusual communion service. A lot of men were touched with this service also, a great many to tears this time and I found this quite interesting. On Friday night we had a beautiful service with people holding candles. I remember how cool it was to start up the hill and hear the people singing even before we could see them and then see their smiling faces holding the candles as we walked by them. I thought it was really good of them to come out like that to support us on our walk. A lot of men were touched by this candlelight thing and it seemed like everyone was crying but me. Then on Saturday morning after we had morning devotion, I was sitting there, with my eyes closed praying, asking God to let me get from this weekend what he wanted me to get. Suddenly, I heard a sound like the brush of angel's wings and then in the distance the soft singing of the angels. The singing got louder and louder and with my head bowed, I felt the presence of someone there. I opened my eyes to see the feet of an angel standing in front of me, only this angel had on a long burnt -orange dress and brown sandals. This angel handed me a long stemmed carnation and at that moment, I finally understood. I understood why the other men had wept after the talks. I understood why the men had wept at dying moments. I understood why the men wept at candle light, because I was weeping over the wonderful realization that I had finally seen the face of Jesus.

My prayer is that the ladies of walk # 157 will see the face of Jesus at some point during this walk. Whether it is during the talks, or during Dying Moments, at Candlelight or at Serenade. May they be able to say as Cleopas and his companion did, "our hearts were burning within us."

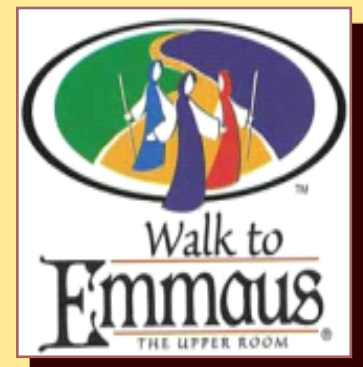

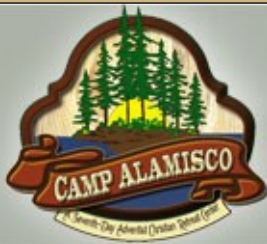

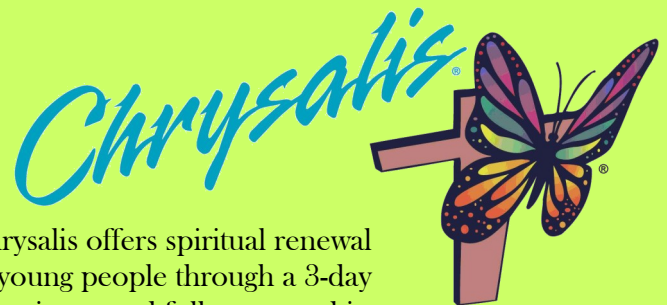
