Gary Silver: Entertain a motion to approve the August 10th minutes.

THE BOARD APPROVES THE AUGUST 10TH, 2023 MINUTES ON A MOTION KASSONDRA JOHNSTONE SECONDED BY MAUREEN STABAK AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED.

<u>Applicant: Joel Kohn Project: Proposed 12,408 Plumbing Warehouse at 308 North Main SBL104.-2-14</u>

Gary Silver: Please explain what is different on the new plans.

Joel Kohn: Proposed 12,408 Square Feet Warehouse for plumbing supplies. Last meeting the board had asked about the sprinkler system, we are not bringing in any water therefore that takes care of that question.

Gary Silver: We need that to be confirmed by our engineer. That is one of the problems. There is some confusion between the engineer and us. That is something outside of our expertise. I forwarded it to the engineer. Hopefully, he will be able to advise us.

Joel Kohn: Typically, that is a code enforcement thing.

Marisol Torrens: It is determined by the code enforcer and the code if the warehouse will need sprinklers.

Joel Kohn: By the way, a certified code enforcement official. We will not need sprinkler for the building but we can confirm with the engineer that's not an issue.

Gary Silver: Marisol, unless you are comfortable making the decision. Are you?

Marisol Torrens: I have to see; it depends on the classification of the building if it is a S1 storage or s2 storage and the size of the buildings. The code has a table, and it tells you whether the proposed size of the building will need a sprinkler system or not.

Gary Silver: If you are comfortable doing that, we do not need the village engineer

Marisol Torrens: No, we do not need the engineer, it just depends on the classification if it is going to be an S1 or S2.

Joel Kohn: If it is S1 it can go up to 12,000 square feet fire area so they can technically have 20,000 sq ft but they have to have separate fire areas not more than 12,000 sq ft and it won't require sprinkler system. S2, they won't require even if they are 20-30 thousand sq ft of course there are other limitations for the size and height of the building. Sprinkler systems are sometimes a design flexibility, so when you have a sprinkler system you have other things that can be less or more.

Gary Silver: If you are correct and Marisol Confirms that, it won't be an issue.

Marisol Torrens: I confirm what the applicant is citing.

Joel Kohn: Thank you. A detailed landscaping plan has been shown. There is a retaining wall design, handicap accessibility, and fence detail. The lighting detail is on their downward facing hooded lights. There is EMS access for fire trucks to get to the back of the building.

Gary Silver: We do need Dave Burke to review everything to make sure there is nothing else that we are missing. No action will be taken tonight due to the request of Dave Burke wanting to see the plans first.

Marisol Torrens: The part that Dave is going to review is water, and what else?

Gary Silver: I am not sure I know water is one of the issues, obviously if there is no sprinkler system requirement and no water being connected, then the water should be a moot issue.

Joel Kohn: Can we get a public hearing scheduled?

Marisol Torrens: The 239 review was supposed to be sent but Jasmine unfortunately thought that the plan design was changed, so she was waiting for new ones to clarify for the record.

Gary Silver: Entertain a motion to declare yourselves a lead agency.
