

JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

Hamilton-Madison House, in partnership with the Grand Street Settlement Community Hub is seeking a temporary full-time Family Therapist/Behavioral Health Clinician who will provide participants and their family members with psychotherapy through the lens of a family systems approach. The Family Therapist will examine social emotional issues that are interfering with the lives of the participant and the family, and perform individual or family counseling as necessary. Other responsibilities include clinical and service record keeping as required by funding sources and in compliance with New York City Department of Health and Mental Hygiene (DOHMH), New York State Office of Addictions and Support Services, New York State Office of Mental Health, and SAMSHA. This position is temporary for one year from date of hire.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Masters in Social Work, Mental Health Counseling, or Family Therapy preferred
- Licensed or Limited Permit as LMSW, LMHC, LMFT or LCSW
- Bilingual English Spanish or English Chinese (Cantonese or Mandarin) required
- Prior community-based health work experienced preferred
- Experience with individuals and family members with mental illness preferred

Responsibilities:

- Provide family psychotherapy, social services, crisis intervention, and treatment planning to clients and their family members
- Work closely with GSS community hub and early childhood to plan and coordinate referrals and client advocacy
- Provide workshop/training seminars and other training activities as needed
- Excellent interpersonal and oral and written communication skills to work with a multidisciplinary team
- Develop and maintain partnerships with other organizations on service delivery, research, community services, and outreach efforts
- Maintain medical records documentation according to HMH, OMH, OASAS, SAMSHA policies and procedures
- Assist in Wellness Specialist tasks and responsibilities as needed
- Sensitivity to diverse cultural and linguistic populations
- Meet productivity and quality assurance goals as set forth by agency
