Team Obedience

A team will consist of 4 handlers and dogs performing the Novice exercises in a drill team manner as described in the Obedience Regulations with these exceptions.

During the Drop On Recall exercise, the first handler will leave their dog on the judge's order,

call and drop the dog when judge signals. When the first dog is down, the next handler will leave their dog, call and drop the dog when judge signals. Each dog will remain in place until all 4 dogs are called and dropped, at which time the judge will command or signal for all handlers to call their dogs. Handlers may use BOTH hand signal and a verbal command to drop the dog.

The group stay exercise will consist of all teams sitting their dogs and walking around the group in the direction the judge indicates. When the handlers return to the front of their dogs, they will remain there until the judge orders them to return. Teams of dog will be placed in a row, with multiple teams being placed back to back with the other teams.


