On Thursday April 4, 2019, at approximately 11:55 AM, Wyckoff Police Officers were dispatched to the intersection of Godwin Avenue and Franklin Avenue on a report of a pedestrian struck by a motor vehicle. Responding officers immediately rendered aid to the 84 year old Wyckoff resident who was struck. The driver of the vehicle was identified as a 57 year old Waldwick resident. She remained on the scene and cooperated with the investigation. The pedestrian was evaluated at the scene by Wyckoff Ambulance Corps and paramedics from Valley Hospital. She was transported to a local hospital with injuries that are not considered to be life threatening. The matter is under investigation by the Wyckoff Police Traffic Bureau and no summonses have been issued at this time.
