

#### TWO NEW HAMS

Even though they aren't scheduled to go to the International Space Station (ISS) until 2013, two astronauts -- Chris Cassidy and Luca Parmitano -- are now licensed amateurs. Cassidy, who received the call sign KF5KDR, is scheduled to head to the ISS in March 2013 as part of Expedition 35. Parmitano, who is KF5KDP, goes up three months later in May, as part of Expedition 36.

Currently, Ronald Garan, KF5GPO, and Catherine Coleman, KC5ZTH Alexander Kaleri, U8MIR, Oleg Skripochka, RN3FU and Paolo Nespoli, IZ0JPA are on board ISS. In June 2011, a new crew reports to the ISS: Michael Fossum, KF5AQG; Sergei Volkov, RU3DIS, and Satoshi Furukawa, KE5DAW. According to the ISS schedule, at least three hams will be on board the ISS at the same time through the end of 2012.
