Our meeting was held at Nicolet School. Those attending were divided into three groups so that we could meet with both the third graders and a teacher in a classroom, while they were having lunch. After the children went out for recess we all met with the principal, Shana Pociask, and all three teachers. There are approximately seventy third graders attending Nicolet this year. The total school population is down this year with a student population of 390 to 400.

A big issue is parental involvement. About 85% of the parents are somewhat involved but only 33% are part of the Nicolet parent teacher Focus Group. There major goal is to get more students to be proficient in reading and math at grade level. One of the three classes is a Bilingual. There are only 20 students in that class. The class is taught by Mr Guillen and is approximately 75% English and 25% Spanish. There is a shortage of bilingual teachers in the Green Bay area.

We had a total of seven members attend this meeting. They included Anne, Maria, Mary-Pat, Ann, Dal, Ben, and Bob R. We neither ate nor had a regular meeting. Anne did bring cookies to share with the children.
