September 6, 2015 Mark 7:31-36 Twenty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Then he looked up to heaven and groaned, and said to him, "Ephphatha"— that is, "Be opened!"

Jesus did not have a horse or a camel. He walked from Tyre, on the east coast of the Mediterranean, north to Sidon, then back southeast to his home area of Galilee. On his way up the coast, then down through valleys and over hills, he taught people that God loved them and cared about them. Jesus traveled slow, but word of his teaching and help of people in need traveled faster. Relatives or friends of a deaf and mute man heard about Jesus and asked him to "lay hands" on the man. Jesus touched his ears and tongue, then looked up to heaven and groaned, and said, "Be opened!" Jesus did not hesitate; he did not make any conditions or take up a collection. Instead, he ordered them not to tell anyone. He was not seeking notoriety, wealth or power. Jesus is challenging us, whom God has blessed with the gifts of hearing, eyesight and speech, to use them for our own benefit and enjoyment, and to use them to speak up when we hear or see others in need.


