Today's Gospel passage is an incisive meditation on the role of Jesus in Salvation. Imagine the emotion that must have run through Our Lord as he told this parable to the Jewish leaders. He was telling the story of his own future. He was describing to them how he would be rejected by them. They did not realize to what he was alluding, but the Lord knew full well what his future would be. His future was to be rejected and killed by them, just as the vineyard owner's son in his story would be rejected and killed. Read this Gospel to yourself one or twice throughout the coming week and just try to imagine the feelings going on inside of the Lord as he hinted at the future that lay in store for him and for them. Each individual man among the Jewish leaders was not "locked in" to this fate, but he could only have avoided it if he had taken the time to hear the words of the Lord and grow in faith.
