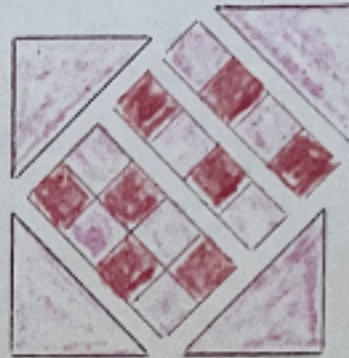

February 2025

Coffin Star

Valentine Red print, pink



Pink: A: Cut two $6 \frac{7}{8}$; cut in half diagonally
B: Cut eight $2 \frac{5}{8}$

Red: C: cut eight $2 \frac{5}{8}$

Sew two rows together: B + C + B + C ; Sew two rows together: C + B + C + B
Sew rows together as in diagram to make square.
Then sew A pieces onto four sides as in diagram.
