



Case Study for a bespoke woodland themed marquee with 200 Guests

Our clients' wish list:

Guests would be approaching the venue on foot across flower meadows from the church and the marquee needed to sit in harmony with the house and the spectacular views. On arrival the lawn at the front of the house would be used for drinks and the house itself would be a picturesque backdrop for the formal photographs as well as being ideally situated for the countryside views and to capture the late afternoon sunlight.



Marquee Design Summary:

Whilst the field offered an ideal position the ground was sloping, so the installation of a laser levelled cassette floor was key. With guests coming through the house into the formal garden to enter the marquee, a walkway was installed over the ha-ha to provide good access. This led into the bar and dancing area and guests continued into the dining room which featured the beautiful views of using clear window walls. The main interior was finished in contemporary ivory flat lining with coffee carpet. Lighting in the dancing area included a fairy light canopy and Gobo lights projecting leaf patterns across the roof. The dining featured pin spot onto tables and up lights all around the marquee providing a subtle additional touch. Including built in portable toilet unit, a generator and back up generator the total cost was £35,000 incl VAT

The Venue:

The marquee was to be sited at the home of the bride's parents and offered a variety of possible sites including a courtyard garden, and orchard (with pigs) and a side lawn. To the rear of the house was a small formal garden and across a ha-ha and a low wall was a field. This provided stunning panoramic views over the Cotswolds and made the perfect site for the main marquee, being close to the drinks reception lawn and the house.
