**A Note from Rick:** Markets were steady to stronger again this week at TLA. The Hay market bounced back slightly after a couple weeks of lower prices. Dairy cattle prices, including dairy replacements, were unchanged and have been for quite some time now. The calf market showed continued strength with prices being \$5-\$10 higher. Slaughter cows were the highlight of the day again. Cows were \$4-\$5 higher across the board. Slaughter cattle, both Holsteins and colored, were steady. The Driving Horse Auction on Saturday was another good one. We had right at 160 horses and the sale went very well. Last week's Benefit Horse Pull and Stallion Presentation was definitely a success. We had 35 Stallions in the presentation and 17 teams of horses in the pull. We had a big and generous crowd and were able to raise over \$17,000 for our local benefit. This year the money was split between the Sunrise Workshop and The Special Education Fund. This community definitely takes care of its own in a big, big way and we are so proud to be a part of it.
