Read through the information on this site to learn about how to complete the FAFSA, including what information is required, deadlines, etc. Use the following framework to develop a comprehensive checklist for information you will need to complete this process.

- Social Security Number
- Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen)
- Driver’s license number
- Parents’ Social Security Numbers
- Most recent income tax documents and financial information for you **and** your parents
